

East Arkansas Family Health Center, INC. (EAFHC)

The clinic will have a mobile unit on one of our campuses each Tuesday unless otherwise predetermined.

What is a mobile clinic? It is a customized motor vehicle that travels to communities to provide health care. They deliver a wide variety of health services and may be staffed by a combination of physicians, nurses, community health workers, and other health professionals.

The clinic will provide wellness, physical evaluations, immunizations, acute and chronic visits, and etc.

A "health history form and consent to treat" must be filled out before your child can go to the clinic. Forms can be pick up from the high school or elementary school.

Students that have Medicaid or AR Kids MUST have EAFHC listed as their primary care provider.

Designated staff will transport students to clinic. Parents do not have to go the clinic with child, but the school encourages parents to call the clinic after the visit for a follow up.

If the parent schedules a visit for the clinic, then he or she much contact the nurse to make sure that we take the student to their scheduled appointment. If you don't call, then we will not know your child has an appointment. For example, your child is having problems with nose bleeds, but you cannot take off work and you know that the mobile clinic will be at the school today, then you call the clinic to schedule an appointment. After you call the clinic, then call the nurse to set up transportation.
