A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

- 1. You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester's grades.
 - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June).
 - b. The first 7 points (including the four points described in "a") must be from LISTS I and II.
 - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II or III).
- 2. You must use **no more than 5 courses** to qualify.
- 3. **No** CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- 4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - a grade of A = 3 CSF points
 - a grade of B = 1 CSF point
 - One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course, <u>up to a maximum of two such points per semester.</u>
 - a grade of C = o CSF points
 - a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

B. Also remember:

- 1. Semester membership is based on work done in the **previous** semester. (Summer school may not be used)
- 2. You must reapply <u>each</u> semester membership is not automatic.
- 3. To be awarded the status of Sealbearer or Life Member, students must be a member for <u>four</u> of their last six semesters during grades 10, 11 or 12. At least ONE semester MUST be in the senior year.
- 4. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS on the reverse side.
