Dear Families of the Graduating Class of 2022,

Graduation at Bell Gardens High School is a special evening that commemorates a milestone in our Lancer's lives through the recognition of their academic achievement. I would like to extend my sincere congratulations to you on the occasion of the graduation of your child from Bell Gardens High School!

The BGHS Commencement Ceremony will take place on Thursday, June 2, 2022 at Weingart Stadium at East Los Angeles Community College (ELAC). The ceremony will begin promptly at 6:00 p.m. To help make this event a truly special occasion for our graduates and families, please carefully review the following guidelines and expectations.

Senior Rehearsal/Practice

ALL graduates are required to attend and participate in the rehearsal ceremony scheduled for Thursday, June 2, 2022 at 7:45 a.m. at Lancer Stadium/ Jaboneria Ave.

- **Graduation Ceremony Plan and Etiquette for Graduates**
 - Graduates must arrive at the Floral Drive Tunnel to line-up by 4:45 p.m. (see map). Any graduates who arrive late will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
 - All outside food and/or drinks will be strictly prohibited and confiscated, if needed. Water will be available for all graduates.
 - Chewing gum, candy, or any snacks is prohibited on the stadium field.
 - Be respectful by limiting your cell phone usage during the ceremony as it may be distracting to your peers. Please do NOT speak on a cell phone or carry on a conversation during the ceremony as this prevents others from hearing and enjoying the ceremony.

- **Commencement Attire for Graduates**
 - Graduation is a formal ceremony. Students are to wear only caps and gowns approved by MUSD and BGHS administration.
 - Graduation regalia/attire is to be worn as it is designed to be worn (caps on top of the head, gowns zipped, etc) with NO adornments and/or decorations.
 - Attire – In addition to caps and gowns, graduates will wear clothes appropriate for this dignified occasion. Dressy attire is expected. Graduating Lancers should strive for a polished, neat, and professional appearance.
 - Any heels such as high heels, heeled pumps, or stilettos are NOT allowed on the stadium field. Wedge heels are permitted.
 - NO adornments (flower and/or money leis) other than BGHS approved club/organization stoles, cords, and medallions provided during our Pride Spectacular event are to be worn with caps and gowns.
 - Please note: Graduates may receive flower/money leis, flags, and gifts from family at the conclusion of the ceremony.

- **Guest Entrance, Parking, Accessibility and Important Information**

- Stadium gates for guests will open at 5:00 p.m.
- Parking is FREE in Parking Structure 3 or the Stadium Lot for all guests.
- There is limited accessible seating. Please make sure to arrive early as this seating fills up fairly quickly. Accessible seating is located on the south side of the stadium accessible through gates 4-7. Seats can not be reserved, so we recommend arriving early.
- The closest handicap parking (12 spots) is on Avalanche Way by the Husky Dog statue.
 - The best drop off for handicap access is Avalanche Way by the Husky Dog statue (UBER/Lyft can drop off in this area there as well).
- Handicap access to the stadium is between concourse tunnels 4 through 8. Seats can not be reserved, so we recommend arriving early.
- Silly string, confetti, airhorns, umbrellas and balloon arrangements are NOT allowed in the stadium as it obstructs the view and/or disrupts the positive experience of guests and spectators.
