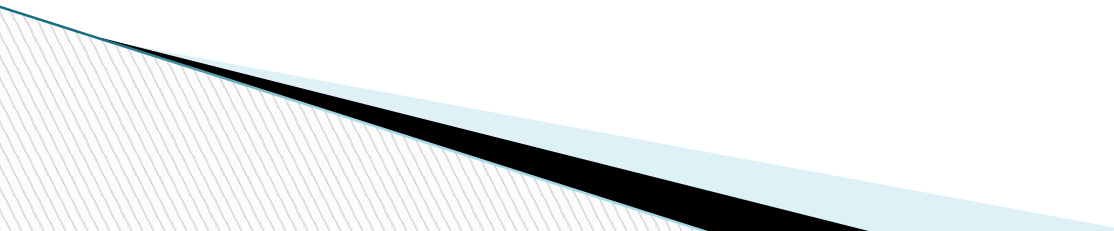


Binders and suggested supplies


- ▶ Pencil pouch (binder specific)



Reading at Home

“How can I help my child?”


- ▶ Have your child read with you.
 - ▶ Discuss what was read (sequence of events)
 - ▶ Discuss the characters in the story
 - ▶ Practice providing main idea and details
 - ▶ Reading Log (in binder)
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Reading Logs

- ▶ Your child must read at least 20 minutes every night.
- ▶ Goals
 - Developing fluency
 - Developing expression
 - High Frequency word practice
 - Improves comprehension

- ▶ Worth over $\frac{1}{2}$ of final homework grade
- ▶ Points
 - Signature with correct date(One point each day)

- Concepts to work on are money, time, and measurement. No Spelling.

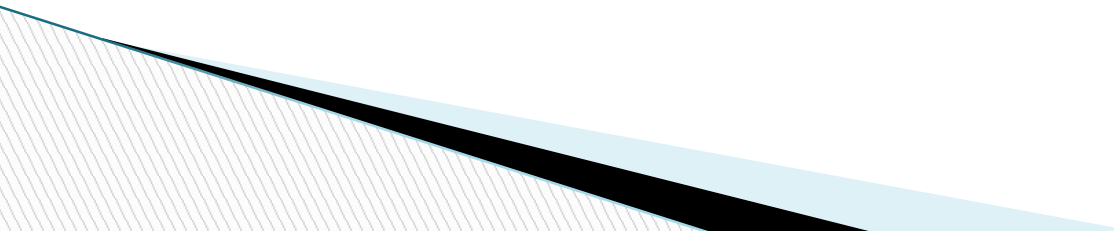
