

Mrs. Tran is the Intervention Counselor. She assists in coordinating support groups to help students with a variety of issues.



Graduation Requirements


- ✓ Pass all required courses
- \checkmark Complete a minimum of 220 credits

How do I earn credits?



- You need credits in order to graduate
- You earn 5 credits for each PASSED class
- You will take 6 classes each semester
- 6 classes x 5 credits = 30 credits for 1 semester
- ▶ There are 2 semesters in a year
- Earn 60 credits in 1 year

To graduate you must have the required coursework of:



Language Arts 4 Years

History/Social Science 3 Years

Science (Life Sci & Physical Sci) 2 Years

Math2 Years

Physical Education (PE)

Fine arts or Foreign Language 1 Year

Health

• 75 Elective credits

1 Semester (5 semester credits)

= **220** credits total

2 Years

A, B, C, & D's are passing grades. F's are NOT passing grades, MUST retake the class

A- G REQUIREMENTS For UC/CSU Admissions Grades MUST be "C" or better

a = History/Social Science - 2 years

b = English - 4 years

c = Mathematics-3 years required, 4 years rec.

d = Laboratory Science - 2 years required, 3 years rec.

e = Language other than English - 2 years required, 3 years rec.

f = Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) -1 year required

g = College Preparatory Electives - 1 year required



It is similar to our graduation requirements - Need to take at least another year of math and science, along with 2 or 3 years of foreign language.

- Complete each task in that order




Balance Your Time


