# CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- Be Safe- move in a safe way, watch out for others.
- Be Responsible- be ready to learn, complete all work.
- Be Respectful- raise your hand to speak, take turns.
- Be Kind- listen to others, use kind words & actions.
- As a class: I recognize positive behavior & correct negative behaviors. When the class attains positive recognition during a day, they earn a short celebration time as a reward.
- Individually: I use a “3 strikes” system. If your child ever has continued difficulty with any of the rules, you will receive a message from me.



# SCHOOL WORK AND HOME SUPPORT



The daily homework is now integrated into classwork. This work is done regularly in class to support the math and language arts lessons we are learning in class.



At home, please be sure to add 20 minutes of daily reading, including sight word practice, as part of the daily support at home. Our agenda will list the sight words for the week. I will send home unit sight word lists for your child to read to me. Send in the list when your child is ready!



Small readers will be sent home for daily reading. Home support includes reading & underlining words with the featured phonics sound, or circling sight words. Our agenda will list the small reader we are using during the week.

The books are delivered to me, then I send them home.
- Lunchboxes stay inside our classroom each morning. Nutritious school lunches are available for free in our cafeteria. If you send a small afternoon snack, it can be stored in the lunchbox or backpack. Water bottles are stored inside the class. Label water bottles & lunchboxes!
- I will celebrate birthdays in our class, but we can **NOT** have treats to eat. We will have to celebrate holidays & other special occasions without treats, as well.



## ADDITIONAL INFO

- If your child is ill, please contact me & call the school office. If your child has any symptoms related to COVID, you will need to get your child tested. If there is ever an exposure in our class, you will be contacted directly.
