Stay on Track...

- It is **essential** that students remain "on track" through high school.
- 2.0 GPA requirement/225 credits
- Failure to pass required classes not only puts the student at risk of not graduating on time, but it also limits the variety of electives available to that student.
- Summer school opportunities are <u>extremely</u> <u>limited!!!</u>

Grading

- The school year is divided into two semesters:
 - Students receive two progress reports, at 6-week intervals, each semester.
 These grade are <u>not</u> permanent. <u>Note</u>: Make sure we have your correct address.
 - Students receive final grades at the end of each semester. These grades are permanent.
- GPA starts to be calculated in 9th grade:
 - Cumulative GPA is calculated at the end of each semester.
- Students generally take 6 classes each year:
 - Each class is worth 5 credits per semester, so students can earn 30 c. semester.
