Introduction of Members & Staff:

Alice Solis, Director of English Learners, Assessment, & Special Programs welcomed members.

Approval of Agenda:

Roll Call

District Information:

I. Turlock Unified School District English Learner Master Plan: Parent Involvement Parent Academy – Presentation by La Casa De La Cultura Chuc, Hugo Hernandez, Creator/Developer/Facilitator

Hugo Hernandez presented information about the Parent Academy. Parents said the parent academy can help parents and would be a good program to implement.

II. Activity – Kelly Villalobos and Erica Maldonado-Higle, District Itinerant English Language Development Teachers

Kelly Villalobos and Erica Maldonado-Higle presented information about developing oral language development. The English Language Development teachers talked about ways parents can support developing their child's/children oral language.

III.
