



ENGLISH LEARNER PLACEMENT


- Student EL Placement starts with the Home Language Survey that is filled out online, by parent, at registration
- If needed, an Initial ELPAC Language
 Assessment is given
- Student is either identified as an English Learner (EL) or Initial Fluent English Proficient (I-FEP)

ENGLISH LEARNER PLACEMENT CHART




ENGLISH LEARNER PROGRAM

- Initial ELPAC score of Novice or Intermediate receive Designated English Language Development (DELD) 30 minutes a day
- Summative ELPAC score of 1, 2, 3 also receive DELD 30 minutes a day (small group)
- All EL students receive Integrated ELD throughout the day



ENGLISH LEARNER PROGRAM


- Student with a Summative ELPAC score of 4 and ELA CAASPP/ESA score of Met or Exceeded standard are considered for Reclassification
- Students with a Summative ELPAC score of 4 without CAASPP/ESA scores can be considered with other criteria



ENGLISH LEARNER TIMELINE

- August 20th: Annual Notification Letters mailed to parents from the District Office
- October Ist: Fall reclassifications due
- November-February: Academic Monitoring Conferences
- January 21st: Spring reclassifications due
- Feb 1st to May 26th: ELPAC Testing

- Meetings: 3rd Tuesday of the Month at 3:30 pm via Zoom



UNIFORM COMPLAINT PROCEDURES

IMPORTANCE OF ATTENDANCE

- Research has shown that your child's regular attendance may be the greatest factor influencing his/her academic success. Achievement: Students who attend school regularly are more likely to **pass** reading and math assessments than students who do not.
- Please call the office at (909) 393-4087 to report an absence. We will need your student's name, grade, teacher, date(s) of absence, and reason.

SPSA GOAL 2021-2022

- All teachers will provide quality first best instruction, targeted intervention, and evidence-based programs to ensure academic success for underperforming groups of students, including English Learners and Students with Disabilities.
- English Learners will increase their English language proficiency by one (I) level on the Summative ELPAC in preparation for reclassification, and experience academic growth as measured by CVUSD Essential Standards Assessments throughout the year and SBAC results at the end of the year. English Learners will show a 5% growth in proficiency on the 2022 Summative ELPAC scores and school reclassification numbers will increase.
- English Learners and Students with Disabilities will show an increase in the number of students meeting standards
 according to the CVUSD Essential Standards Assessments throughout the year and SBAC results at the end of the
 year.
- School Level SMART Goal:
- On the 2022 CAASPP, the percent of students scoring "Standards Met" and "Standards Exceeded" (combined) in ELA will increase from 53% to 60%, and in Math will increase from 39% to 60%


Understanding the **ELPAC**Reports and **Areas**.
