Dear Senior Highlander Families,

Our Graduation ceremony for the Class of 2023 is just around the corner. We would like to share our expectations and provide information that will make the end of the year more enjoyable for our graduates and their families. Upland High School traditionally has enjoyed outstanding Graduation ceremonies and we need your help to ensure this tradition continues.

The behavior of the graduates is essential to the success of the Graduation ceremony. It is important to show respect for the speakers and provide them with an opportunity to be heard. It is also very important to allow each graduate the chance to have their name heard by the audience and to have the recognition of receiving their diploma with everyone watching. Any behavior that distracts from the student, speakers or the presentation of the diplomas spoils the ceremony for others. This is both a joyous and serious occasion; the time to celebrate is after the Graduation ceremony.

Seniors' clothing at the Graduation ceremony also contributes to the atmosphere of the event. Students should wear attire appropriate to a formal event, and comfortable shoes, as they will be standing for long periods of time (no flip-flops). Optional cap decorations and traditional tribal regalia/recognized objects of cultural or religious significance must follow guidelines published in our Graduation Attire Information and must not create a substantial disruption of, or material interference with the ceremony.

We ask that you take the time to discuss appropriate behavior with your graduate. Please encourage your senior to wear the recommended clothing. With your help, the Class of 2023 will have a Graduation ceremony that reflects the pride of all students, family members, and guests.

Please encourage your student to continue regular attendance. Any unexcused absences will need to be made up before the graduation ceremony.

During the fall and spring semesters, counselors review grades and credits with every senior. Counselors also inform parents of every senior who is in danger of not graduating. Any senior who participates in the Graduation ceremony must meet all graduation requirements set forth by the Upland Unified School District Board of Education and not violate the senior contract. Please encourage your child to work hard for the remaining months. If you have any questions regarding your graduate's progress toward graduation, please contact their counselor.

We look forward to a great ending for the outstanding Class of 2023. Enjoy these last few months of the high school experience with your senior!

#### SENIOR COMMENCEMENT ASSEMBLY

All seniors must report for the Senior Commencement Assembly at 7:45 a.m. on **Thursday June 8** in the Highlander Auditorium. Attendance will be taken.

#### COMMENCEMENT JUNE 8, 2023 AT 5:00 PM AT TOYOTA ARENA

Seniors must report to the Toyota Arena **no later than 3:30 p.m. attired in cap and gown.** There are no changing or storage areas at the Arena, so please come fully dressed and do not bring any items with you. Toyota Arena requires that <u>all</u> graduates and parents be searched by Arena security prior to entering. Graduates should not bring any items that may cause a distraction during the ceremony. No unauthorized items may be worn over the gown. Toyota Arena will not allow balloons, horns, wrapped gifts, and other items at their discretion into the Arena. Wrapped gifts will have the wrapping removed prior to entering the Arena or the item must remain in your vehicle.

#### **GRADUATION ATTIRE INFORMATION**

#### **CAP DECORATIONS**

Students must adhere to the following guidelines:

- No part of the cap decoration should...
  - Threaten any person or group's safety
  - Be lewd, obscene, vulgar, or profane
  - Refer to controlled substances, weapons, or be of a sexual nature (includes advertisements, symbols, acronyms, slogans, pictures)
  - Promote any gang affiliation
  - Make noise
- The cap decoration should also **NOT** be three-dimensional. It should lie flat on the top surface of the cap.

Please note that you will not be given another cap if you do not like the decoration that you make for it. We would suggest practicing before creating the final decoration.

#### SPECIAL REGALIA

The California State Legislature has recently passed AB 1248, adding Education Code section 35183.1. This code allows students to wear "traditional tribal regalia *or* recognized objects of cultural *or* religious significance" at graduation ceremonies (emphasis added). These items must not cause a substantial disruption of or material interference with the ceremony. These are completely optional, and any student who chooses to wear one does so with the realization that it may cover all or some of any school-provided graduation regalia.

The Upland High School Administration reserves the right to disallow any cap decoration or item they deem to be objectionable; these will be confiscated and not returned.

#### UPLAND HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION AGREEMENT Thursday June 08, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. at Toyota Arena

Congratulations! Graduation Day is rapidly approaching. The Board of Education will be sponsoring a joyous and meaningful Graduation ceremony to honor your successful completion of the Upland High School graduation requirements.

Participation in the Graduation ceremony is voluntary. All students who choose to participate are subject to qualification. The following requirements **must be completed by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 07, 2023:** 

- 1. All academic requirements, as established by the Board of Education
- 2. All financial obligations, including lost or damaged books, library fines, and unreturned school property

Prior to, and during the ceremony, all school rules regarding student conduct will be enforced:

- 1. No smoking, vaping, or tobacco use
- 2. Anyone under the influence or in possession of any controlled substance or object will not be allowed to participate in the Graduation ceremony
- 3. No disorderly conduct at any time
- 4. No selfie-sticks
- 5. Mandatory attendance at the Graduation assembly on Thursday, June 08, 2023 at 7:45 a.m. in the Highlander Auditorium
- 6. Appropriate attire beneath the cap and gown. Students should dress appropriately for a formal event.
- 7. Optional cap decorations and traditional tribal regalia/recognized objects of cultural or religious significance must follow guidelines published on UHS Senior website and must not create a substantial disruption of, or material interference with the ceremony

## Students committing any infraction prior to and/or during the ceremony may be withdrawn from participation in the Graduation ceremony.

Graduates, please do not bring backpacks, purses, etc. to the Graduation ceremony; storage is not available. You are responsible for your personal belongings. All graduates and guests will be subject to search by the Toyota Arena and UHS security staff.

Each senior will receive four (4) complimentary general admission tickets for the commencement ceremony. Additional tickets may be purchased on the <u>UHS Student Online Store</u> beginning May 2. Ticket pick-up will be during lunch and after school beginning May 23.
