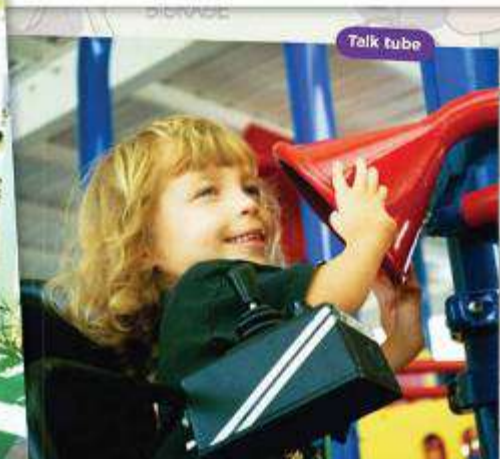
#### Persuasion

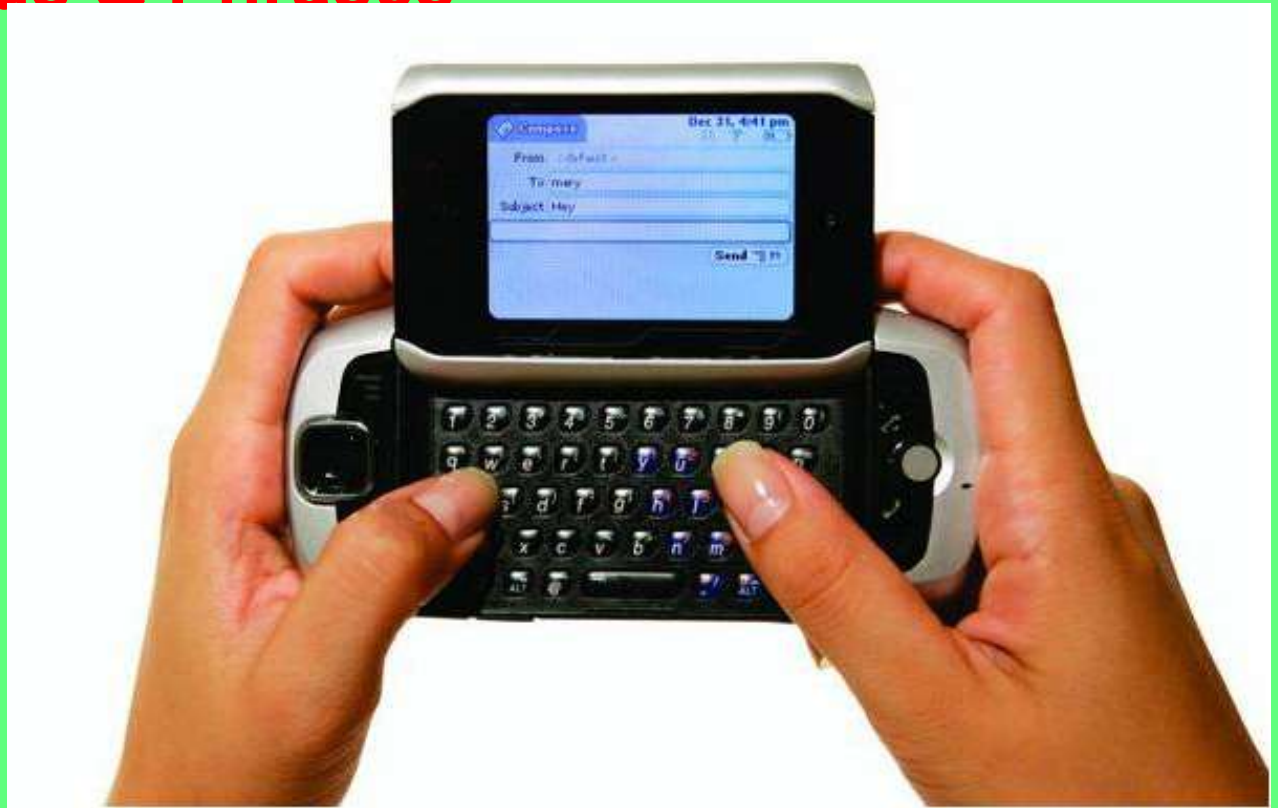

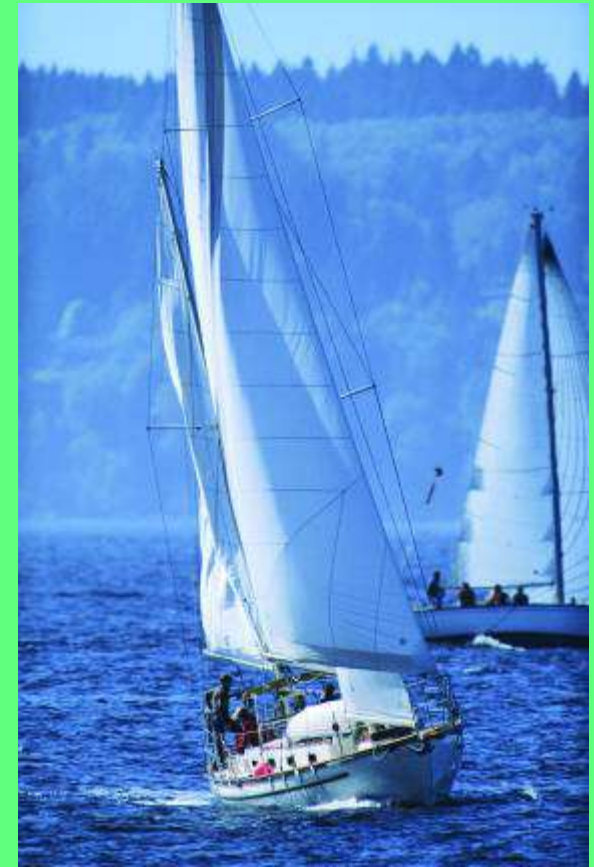


In English, we use **far from being a** to express an opposite. *Far from being a* means “the opposite, or in contrast.”

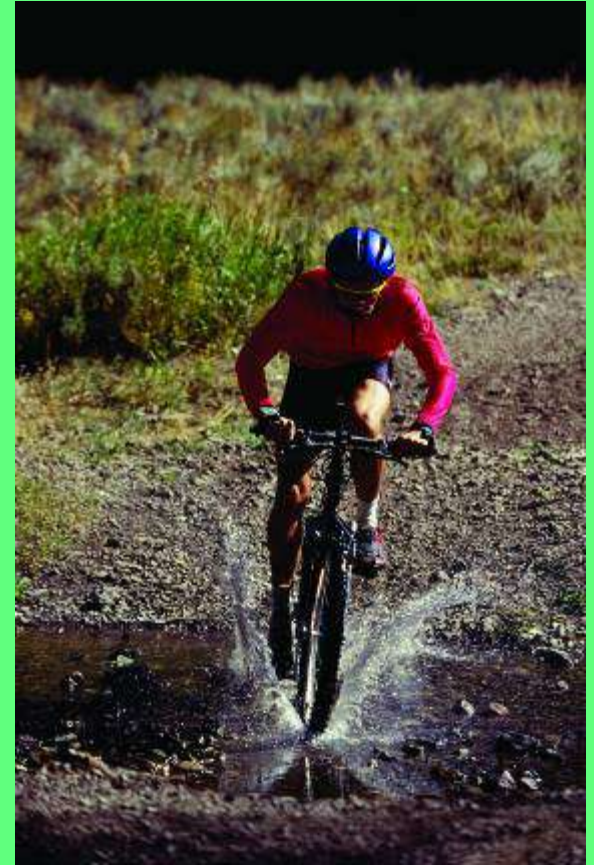

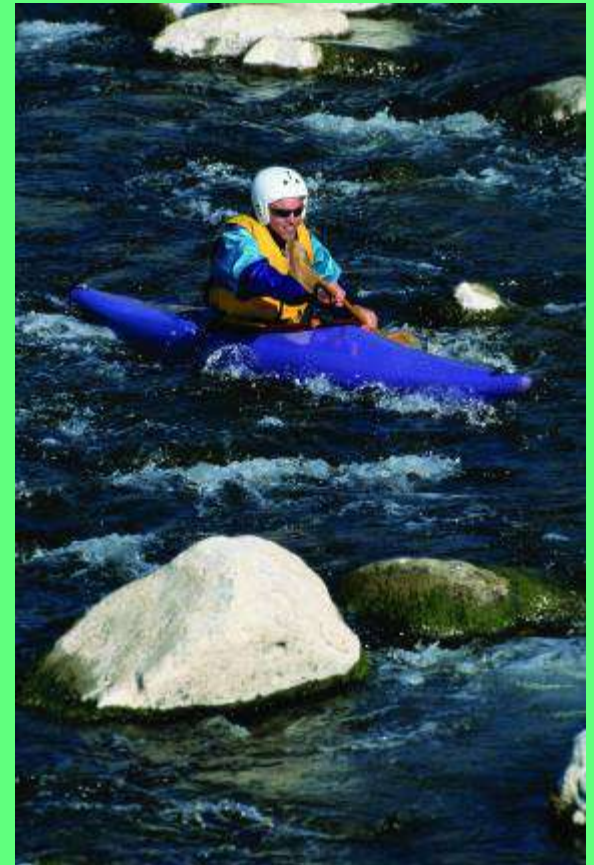
