- Your works cited page must be formatted in MLA.
 - 12 point font
 - Times New Roman
 - 1" margins
 - Double spaced

Basic Rules

IN addition.....

- NO additional spacing between sources
- Indent 5 spaces after first line of each source (hanging indent).
- Alphabetize
- Title = Works Cited

Books

1. Name of Author (last name, first name)
2. Title of book (italicized)
3. Place of Publication
4. Publisher
5. Year of Publication
6. Medium of Publication

Books

Lastname, Firstname. *Title of Book*.
Place of Publication: Publisher, Year of
Publication. Medium of Publication.

Gleick, James. *Chaos: Making a New
Science*. New York: Penguin, 1987.
Print.

Online Sources

1. Author and/or editor names (if available)
- 2. Article name in quotation marks (if applicable)**
3. Title of the Website, project, or book in italics.
4. 4.Any version numbers available, including revisions, posting dates, volumes, or issue numbers.
- 5.Publisher information, including the publisher name and publishing date (Write n.p. for each if not available).
- 6.Take note of any page numbers (if available).
- 7.Medium of publication.**
- 8.Date you accessed the material.**

Online Sources

Editor, author, or compiler name (if available).
"Title of Article." Name of Site. Version
number. Name of institution/organization
affiliated with the site (sponsor or
publisher), date of resource creation (if
available). Medium of publication. Date of
access.

Articles/Scholarly Journals

- article's author (s),
- title of the article in quotations marks
- Periodical title italicized.
- date of publication (day, month, year)
