- Times New Roman
- -1'' margins
- Double spaced

Basic Rules

IN addition.....

- NO additional spacing between sources
- Indent 5 spaces after first line of each source (hanging indent).
- Alphabetize
- Title = Works Cited

- 1. Name of Author (last name, first name)
- 2. Title of book (italicized)
- 3. Place of Publication
- 4. Publisher
- 5. Year of Publication
- 6. Medium of Publication

Place of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication. Medium of Publication.

Online Sources
