

# Advanced Placement Examination Registration Information

#### 2018-2019

Advanced Placement (AP) examinations are the culmination of the AP course. Therefore, Santiago High School holds the expectation that all students enrolled in AP courses will take the College Board end of course exam in May. The majority of colleges provide students who pass the exam with a 3 or better college credit for the course, which can save parents and students a significant amount of tuition and time.

### **How to Register**

Students can register online from any computer with internet access. On our school website, you will find the link <a href="www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/050692">www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/050692</a>. Students MUST answer all of the required questions accurately, as answer documents will be printed with this information and will be unchangeable after the exams are ordered. Therefore, we strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered and all information correct. Registration will not be complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end.

#### **Cost and Payment Options**

The cost to take an exam is \$98.00 per test, except AP Seminar and AP Research courses cost \$146.00. You may pay by credit card, debit card, or personal check. Please be sure to have your credit card or debit card available before beginning online registration. If you pay by check, you will have to mail the check to the address provided to you on the registration site.

Fee reductions are available for students who participate in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. All students who are qualified or those who need to be qualified for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program are to report to Mrs. Giles in the Assistant Principal's Office to receive paperwork that must be completed, signed, and returned prior to registering for the exam.

## When to Register

- Tuesday, January 22, 2019 at 12:01 a.m. –Registration begins
- Friday, February 22, 2019 until 11:59 p.m. –Last day to register without a \$10.00 late fee per exam
- Friday, March 1, 2019 until 11:59 p.m. –Last day to order and pay for exams with a \$10.00 late fee for each test ordered. Exams that have not been paid by this date will be cancelled and no exams will be ordered.

#### **Additional Information**

If you are on a spring athletic team, check with your coach to make sure you have no conflicting games on your test day before you order your exams. Also, if you have two tests on the same day/same time, please see Dr. Smith in the Assistant Principal's Office.
