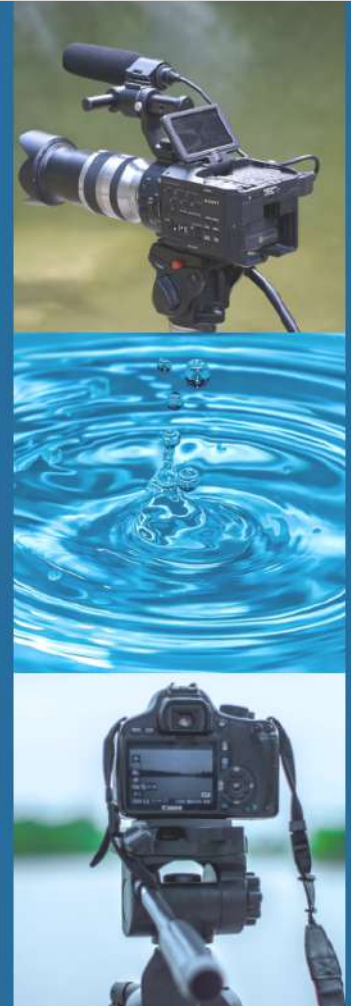

Credit Recovery

Virtual Credit Recovery classes will be held at each high school.

Face-to-Face Credit Recovery (Teacher-Taught) will be held at Etowah HS at Etowah East.

Initial Credit for Personal Fitness and Health

Cherokee County School District will offer an opportunity for rising ninth graders to take Personal Fitness (morning session) and/or Health (afternoon session) at two locations: Cherokee HS (for Cherokee, Creekview and Sequoyah students) and Etowah HS at Etowah East (for Etowah, River Ridge and Woodstock students). Cost of each course will be \$200.
