---

1. **Protect your GPA**

3. Attend *free* Terrier Tutoring weekly and create a study space and study schedule at home
4. Check in with your teachers during ARP (8:00-8:20 AM every day)
5. Read your email daily -- check it before Snapchat, Tic Tok, Instagram etc.
6. Join a club or a sport within the first month of high school
7. Listen to the Daily Announcements - you can also read them online via *Terriernet*
8. Show up, set goals, and do your best each day
9. Check in with your School Counselor often & complete all assigned Naviance tasks (*4 year plan*)
