

GO-AP Exam Payment Information

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on college tuition.

REGISTRATION: For GOHS Students Visit [GOHS TOTAL REGISTRATION LINK](#)

Parents and students must both be present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

There are 2 steps to register for an AP Exam. If both steps are not complete, the test will NOT be ordered.

- 1. Add the AP Classroom of the course. You will use the Join Code provided by your AP teacher and indicate that you would like to take the exam.**
- 2. Pay for the Exam through Total Registration [GOHS TOTAL REGISTRATION LINK](#)**

CANCELLED EXAMS: Any student who requests to cancel an exam (including Free and Reduced) after November 11th will be charged a \$40 non-refundable fee. After March 11th, there are NO REFUNDS.

NO MAKE-UP EXAMS: If you are absent on exam day you purchase an alternative exam.

FINANCIAL AID: Fees for AP Exams are reduced to \$20 for low-income families. To request a fee reduction, the student must present a copy of the District APPROVED letter for Free and Reduced lunch and a completed Student Eligibility Form to acurtis1@tvusd.us. Meal applications for Free or Reduced Price Meals are available at the Temecula Valley School District Nutrition Services Department website <http://temeculafreshfood.com>. Approval of free/reduced meal applications may take up to 10 days. All late and cancellation fees will apply to Free and Reduced Lunch students, per the calendar schedule above. **Your letter must be turned into the office no later than October 1st in order to avoid a late fee.**
