

WHS Exam Exemption Checklist

High school students will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:

- The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 3 absences (excused or unexcused) in the class.
- The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 2 absences (excused or unexcused) in the class.

Please Note:

- Exam exemptions are not available in courses which require the administration of an End of Course or state mandated final exam.
- Students enrolled in AP courses will still be required to take the AP exam.
- Teacher-made tests do not include any developed and administered by NCDPI (i.e. EOC, CTE, field tests, etc.), or any AP exams.

The attendance in PowerSchool is the official record of attendance. Our attendance counselor, Mrs. Glenna Bowen, has updated and coded the absences according to UCPS Board of Education policy.

If a student has a question and/or concern about his/her attendance record and the associated exam exemption, he/she should speak with Mrs. Bowen in the attendance office or assistant principal Mr. Jeff Brookshire.
