AP EXAMS FAQ

When is registration for AP exams?

From January 31st- February 28th online at www.totalregistration.net/AP/053234

Are there refunds?

No refunds in any amount after March 7th (\$5 fee for refund)

Can non-FHS students sign up to take an exam at Foothill?

If we are offering the exam being requested and have space available, yes. Approval is through Mr. D'Errico.

How much do exams cost?

\$96 per exam

How do I know if I will qualify for a reduced exam fee?

If you participate in the Free/ Reduced Lunch Program, the online system will notify the school and Mr. D'Errico will give approval for the fee reduction. If you do not participate in the program, you will need to apply in order for a fee reduction to be approved.

When are AP exams?

May 7th-May 18th. Morning exams begin promptly at 7:30AM and afternoon exams begin at 12PM. The date of each exam is pre-determined by the CollegeBoard and cannot be modified or adjusted by individual school sites. Every school giving AP exams will administer them in this window.

What exams does Foothill offer?

FHS only offers exams for the AP courses offered here:

Chemistry (5/7, AM)Psychology (5/7, PM)Spanish Language (5/8, AM)Physics 1 (5/8, PM)English Literature (5/9, AM)Physics 2 (5/9, PM)US Gov. & Pol. (5/10, AM)

Comp. Sci. A (5/15, PM) French Language (5/15, PM) English Language (5/16, AM) Statistics (5/17, PM) Microeconomics (5/18, AM) European History (5/18, PM)

What if I am unable to take the exam on this date?

There is a \$45 fee to take a late exam and the reason for the exam must fall under certain qualifications (e.g. athletic/ academic contest or event). Late testing must be approved by Mr. D'Errico and the order must be made by the first week in May. All late tests occur May 21st-25th.
