What is the ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is designed to specifically assess a students' preparedness entering the health science fields. Most likely, you've been asked to take the TEAS as part of your basic admissions requirements for your nursing or allied health program. That's because studies show a consistent link between a student's performance on the TEAS and future academic success.

The ATI TEAS exam is comprised of 170 questions, 20 of which are unscored pretest items. Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills you will need to perform in class in the areas of: Reading, Math, Science and English and Language Usage.

How to register for TEAS at ATI:

Have you been instructed by the school in which you're applying to register for TEAS at ATI? Let's get started.

Step 1: Visit atitesting.com/teas/register and select the register now button.

Step 2: You will be prompted to choose how you would like to take your proctored exam – In Person or Online. Choose Online.

Step 3: Once you are directed to the new window, select the Proctor - Program Type drop down. Here you will choose ATI Remote Proctor – Nursing OR ATI Remote Proctor – AH (Allied Health). Then, select the testing date range that meets the admissions requirements set by the institution(s) in which you are applying.

Select the session date and time that works best for your schedule and continue to the Product Details page.

Step 4: Here, you will review all testing information before continuing with your registration, as well as purchase additional transcript credits. Select "Continue Registration" to proceed.

*Note: One transcript is included with your exam registration. You may select the institution in which to send your transcript following the completion of your ATI TEAS exam. You will need to log into your student account and select SEND TRANSCRIPT under TEAS Activity.

Additional transcripts may be purchased to send to alternate institutions. You may purchase these credits now or after your exam via your student account.

Step 5: Review your order and proceed to checkout to complete.

Step 6: Check your email! Following registration, you will receive an email confirmation from ATI. This includes test details, dry run information and more.
