Re: Class Size Report for the 2017-2018 School Year

Brookfield Board of Education class size guidelines:

- **Center School**:17-20 students with a target of 19 students;
- **Huckleberry Hill School**: 19-21 students with a target of 20 students;
- Whisconier Middle School:... 21-23 students for grades 5 & 6 with a target of 22 students;
- Whisconier Middle School:... 20-22 students for grades 7 & 8 with a target of 21 students; and
- **Brookfield High School**: 19-21 students with a target of 20 students.

The class size guidelines for elective/UNAH/PE classes are as follows: Art, Family & Consumer Science, Technology Education and Music classes are 15-19 students and Music may vary depending on the ensembles; Health, Physical Education and Business classes are 21-23 students.

Center Elementary School

- 0 of the 17 general education classes (0%) are below class size guidelines of 17-20 students
- 17 of 17 general education classes are within (100%) the class size guideline of 17-20 students
- 0 of 17 general education classes are above (0%) the class size guideline of 17-20 students

- 5th Grade:

• Of the 35 sections of classes of math, literacy, science, and social studies, 22 sections (62%) of them are above the recommended class size guidelines.

- 6th Grade:

• Of the 42 sections of classes of math, literacy, science, and social studies, 28 sections (67%) of them are above the recommended class size guidelines.

- 7th Grade:

• Of the 51 sections of classes of math, literacy, science, social studies and World Language, 12 sections (24%) of them are above the recommended class size guidelines.

- 8th Grade:

• Of the 54 sections of classes of math, literacy, science, social studies and World Language, 31 sections (57%) of them are above the recommended class size guidelines.

UNAH - Specials

21st Century Skills: Of the 20 sections in grades 7-8, 8 sections are above the class size guidelines. (40%)

Art Classes: Of the 40 sections, 14 sections are above the class size guidelines. (35%)

Performing Art Classes: Of the 40 sections, 10 sections are above the class size guidelines. (25%)

Technology Education Classes: Of the 40 sections, 14 sections are above the class size guidelines. (35%)

General Music Classes: Of the 40 sections, 13 sections are above the class size guidelines. (33%)

World Language 5th & 6th: Of the 20 sections, 7 sections are above the class size guidelines. (35%)

Chorus

- 5th Grade Chorus includes 36 students
- 6th Grade Chorus includes 42 students
- · 7th Grade Chorus includes 24 students
- · 8th Grade Chorus includes 42 students

Band

- 5th Grade Band includes 52 students
- 6th Grade Band includes 42 students
- 7th Grade Band includes 24 students
- · 8th Grade Band includes 42 students

<u>Physical Education Classes</u>: Of the 120 sections, 47 sections are **above** the class size guidelines. **(39%)** <u>Health Classes</u>: Of the 80 sections, there are 30 sections are **above** the class size guidelines. **(38%)**

^{*****}There are 3 Physical Education teachers - because students take 3 rotations of PE a year.

There are 3 Music teachers - The band/chorus teachers split the rotations depending on the grade level because they have individual and group lessons. There are 2 Health teachers - because students take 2 rotations of Health a year.

Brookfield High School

English Classes: 53 sections, 13 sections (24%) are above the class size guidelines of 21 with the largest class at 28 students.

<u>Math Classes:</u> 54 sections, 20 sections (37%) are above the class size guidelines of 21 with the largest class at 29 students.

<u>Social Studies Classes</u>: 56 sections, 27 sections (48%) are above the guidelines of 21 with the largest class at 29 students.

<u>Science Classes</u>: 57 sections, 32 sections (56%) are above the guidelines of 21 with the largest class at 24 students.

World Language Classes: 33 sections, 13 sections (40%) are above the guidelines of 21 with the largest class at 29 students.

Spanish enrollments: 553 French enrollments: 59

<u>Career and Technical Classes:</u> 29 sections, 10 sections (34%) are above the guidelines of 19 with the largest class at 29 students.

Business Classes: 18 sections, 5 sections (28%) over the guidelines of 19 with the largest class at 28 students.

Art Classes: 19 sections, 2 sections (10%) are above the guidelines of 19 with the largest class at 24 students.

<u>Music Classes:</u> 18 sections, 6 sections (33%) are above the guidelines of 19 with the largest class at 81 students.

<u>Health Classes</u>: 20 sections, 10 sections (50%) are above the guidelines of 23 with the largest class at 30 students.

PE Classes: 33 sections, 28 sections (85%) are above the guidelines of 23 with the largest class at 32 students.
