Grading

Each nine weeks, a grade will be given for each student taking this course. Primary factors determining grades are:

Individual growth and progress in theater discipline observed

Active productive participation in all rehearsals and performances observed

Acceptable positive self-disciplined rehearsal attitude (conduct grade)

Rehearsal and Performance Attendance

Repertoire checks as well as some daily assignments

Grades are divided up by the following percentages:

60%-Daily Grade: Mostly based on participation and following instructions. These grades are given based on following the routine in class, working on music outside of class, showing up for trips, performances, etc., and putting forth 100% effort each day. Each day the students will be given a grade for participation. If a note has been taken about participation, the student's grade will be affected and the notes will be kept on file. A conduct grade will be given each nine weeks as a part of the daily grade. Some daily assignment grades will be factored into this category also.

40%-Test Grade: Several different factors make up the test grade percentage. For every performance or competition the group performs, the individual student will rate his or her performance honestly for a grade. The teacher will also give the student a rating and the scores will be combined. (The rating will come based on accuracy of performance knowledge, performance appearance, and attendance.) The students will also be given repertoire checks periodically to make sure that the he or she individually knows his or her part. There will be occasionally written tests over the history of theater and technique.

Attendance

In a performing company, it is so important to show up. If you are sick, the group would prefer you not share your germs. But if you are here, and in class, you WILL rehearse. THE ONLY OPTION TO EXEMPT A PERFORMANCE IS A HOSPITAL NOTE, A FAMILY DEATH. OR DOCTOR'S EXCUSE. GUARDIAN'S EXCUSES WILL NOT BE TAKEN. If a student misses a dress rehearsal or performance for an approved reason, he or she must complete an alternate assignment to make up the grade.

REHEARSAL AREA RULES FOR DRAMA

- Enter quietly. Place personal belongings against table outside, grab your folder, and be seated immediately in your correct seat for attendance.
 - Participate in all warm ups (breathing, physical, and vocal) in an appropriate manner.
- Remain in your assigned seat-Face forward-Hands to yourself and feet on the floor at all times.
- Only water bottles and unopened food allowed in the room at all times. Evidence of food and/or gum will result in consequences.
- Absolutely NO cell phones (see Cell Phone Policy in Handbook) unless instructed.
- Respect the director, the members, and the property of MSHS Choral and Drama Program.

Failure to follow the above rules will immediately affect grades for individuals as well as dismissal from the MSHS drama program.

Course Fees and Scripts

- Membership Fee: Each member of drama must pay a \$25.00 fee to join. This fee pays for scripts, equipment, transportation, competition entries, etc. Member fees are due by August 9. ALL fees must be paid online. You can find the online payment link from the high school website or from my page on the chorus page listed under the faculty under "Hannah Bradford". If you prefer to pay at the school, you are welcome to come to the office and use your card to pay through our Square software.
- When receiving a script, you are welcome to right on it with pencil. Before returning the script, erase all markings. Do NOT mark in pen, highlight, or do anything destructive to the script.
 Damage or makings to the script will result in a financial penalty according to the publisher's guidelines.
