> IMPORTANT TIPS

- Every Child, Every Chance, Every Day: We are all here for the students...be their #1 fan, supporter, and encourager...do whatever it takes for them to be successful!
- Provide instruction bell to bell every day. Include bell-ringers and exit slips. Use to plan next lesson.
- Set high expectations for all students
- Focus on developing critical thinking skills.
- Reading and writing across the curriculum every day, every class.

- Purposeful planning is key....write effective lesson plans with before, during, & after strategies, and document standards taught and assessed weekly.
