### A Message from Principal Dan Bollinger

Bulldog Families,

In last month's newsletter, I commented on how quickly we made it through the first half of the year and now the second semester is well underway. I have already had a couple of planning meetings with Seniors to prepare for graduation, and we are also in the thick of some master schedule discussions prior to students building their class schedules for next year.

February may not be as busy of a month as May, but there's still plenty to note on your calendars. Parent-teacher-conferences are February 23rd from 3:30-7:30pm. ### Counselor's Corner

#### **ALL STUDENTS**

Log on to your Naviance account to make sure that your current email and phone number listings are correct. If you add colleges you are thinking about to your Naviance list, you will get an automatic invitation to meet with that college's rep when/if they visit PHS. If your email is up-to-date, you will receive several notifications throughout the year about scholarships and college information.

The Naviance atom is found in students' ClassLink accounts. Students: Use your StudentVue username and password to log on. Parents who want to be added to their students account can contact MaryJane. Seriani@d51schools.org.

### **SENIOR FAMILIES**

If your student is planning to attend college next year, you will need to help him or her fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA.gov). It is important to complete the FAFSA as soon as you can, as college aid monies are limited. Make sure you go to the correct website, <a href="www.FAFSA.gov">www.FAFSA.gov</a> and <a href="www.FAFSA.com">NOT www.FAFSA.com</a>. Filling out the FAFSA is free! Also, make sure you select that correct college semester: Fall 2022. You will need your 2020 tax forms in order to complete the FAFSA.

### **ATTENTION ACCEPTED SENIORS**

Colleges communicate important information with you through your student online portal (ie: MavZone @ CMU or MyCUBoulder @ UC Boulder). Do not miss scholarships, housing information, class registration or important dates and activities. Check your portal at least once a week!

#### **DECEMBER EARLY COMPLETERS**

We encourage all seniors who completed their coursework in December to keep in touch with the Counseling Office and/or the Class of 2022 Facebook page/Instagram for information on senior meetings, graduation practice, and important deadlines!

#### Scholarship Brochure

Seniors, please bring a copy of any scholarships awarded or offered from ALL colleges (even if you do not plan to attend that school) to the counseling office before the April 18<sup>th</sup> deadline.

CMU is hosting a FAFSA completion workshop and information night for all D51 seniors and their families. ### WCCC Tech Scholars Interest Application Open for 2022/2023!




Staff from WCCC will be at PHS on February 10<sup>th</sup> to meet with students and answer questions.






