Dear RMS Parents -

There are two items I want to communicate:

1) School of Choice window is coming. If you live outside of the RMS attendance area, you must complete the School of Choice process. If you are currently enrolled at RMS as a school of choice student, you **DO NOT** have to re-apply to return to RMS next year.

The school of choice window will open at 10 a.m. on Monday March 5, 2018 and will close at 4 p.m. on Friday March 30, 2018. All SOC applications will be done thru ParentVUE. All parents/guardians who wish to fill out a SOC application will need to have a current ParentVUE account. If you need a parent view account, please see Mary in our Main Office.

#### 2) Grades

To access your child's grades/report card from Q2, log in to Parentvue. Using the tabs on the left side of the screen click on "Report Card". You are also more than welcome to give Mary in our office a call or email and we will print your child's report card.

To see your child's progress anytime during the quarter, log in to Parentvue. Click on "Grade book" from the left side of the screen. You're child's courses will appear with N/A next to each course. **Click on the N/A** and it will take you to the specific grades your child has earned on different assignments.

I recognize that our Parentvue system has been less than ideal and confusing. Next year we are looking forward to a changed gradebook system, it is called Schoology. We are hopeful that the new system will be better.

Heart & Sole is an <u>after school program</u> that uses the power of running to prepare girls for a lifetime of self- respect and healthy living. Through interactive activities, such as running, playing games, and discussing important issues, GOTR participants learn how to celebrate being teen girls. The program focuses on building self-esteem and improving emotional and physical health. During the 10-week program, girls are empowered with a greater self-awareness, a sense of achievement, and a foundation in team building to help them become strong, contented, and self-confident young women.

Each session is led by trained, volunteer female coaches who guide and mentor girls through a fun and uplifting curriculum. Coaches teach specific life lessons such as dealing with body image and the media, resisting peer pressure, making healthy decisions and contributing to the community. Along the way, the girls train together to walk or run a 5K (3.1 mile) event.

Registration fee is \$55.00 (scholarships are readily available).


Group size is limited, so early registration is encouraged. Registration closes on February 11th or when the site fills, whichever happens first, so don't delay  $\blacksquare$ 


