
In order to streamline the check in process for our shared responsibility form, we are now piloting the FEVER FREE app at Ernie Pyle. We will be starting this on Monday, May 17. Sometime this weekend please download the app and familiarize yourself with the platform. You can even sign in on Saturday or Sunday to see the whole process.

All on campus families will need to submit your responses on the app on a daily basis beginning Monday, May 17, 2021, **prior to 8:00 am.** 

To register: Download the fever free app on your phone or use the browser on your device. To register for the Fever Free app you will need to use your student's District assigned email account. This account can be found in your Aeries Parent Portal account by navigating to the Student Info.>Demographics>Student Data 2 tab. The email account is located in the Stu Email Address box.

There are two ways to register for your Fever Free account: 1) Directly on the Fever Free app, or 2) Via an email sent to your student's email account.

Register Via the App



- 1. Install the Fever Free app on your phone.
- 2. Once the app is downloaded, open the app and click "Create an Account"
- 3. Fill in the fields requested with your student's name and email address. You will not need to include a phone number. Make sure to choose a secure password that is not easily guessed.
- 4. Click Create Account.
- 5. Read through the Welcome screen and check mark the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. Click "Allow" to enable in-app notifications.

How to Submit a Health Check on the Mobile App

- 1. Open up your Fever Free app.
- 2. Select "Submit Health Check.
- 3. Tap the green check mark toconfirm a temperature of less than 100.4 degrees.
- 4. Next, carefully follow along and read through the questionnaire.
- 5. Tap "Submit" when finished.
- 6. After submission, you will see one of the following statuses:
  - a. Pass: You are Fever Free and Symptom Free. You are cleared to arrive at your organization. Please present your Clearance Badge upon arrival at your destination.

- b. Fail: A fever was detected and/or a prohibited symptom or question was selected. Select "Next Steps" to access your organization's health protocol to understand what to do next.
- c. Quarantined: Please note that this status does not necessarily mean COVID-19 exposure. if you are placed under this status, this likely means you already communicated to a designated health manager of your organization and they determined you are not cleared to arrive. This status means you cannot gain a Clearance Badge until further notice.

How to Submit a Health Check on a Desktop or Browser Window

- 1. Go to feverfree.ai and log in using your email and password.
- 2. Click "Submit Health Check", the second option on the menu.
- 3. Click the green check button to confirm a temperature of less than 100.4.
- 4. Next, carefully follow along and read through the questionnaire. Select the appropriate responses.
- 5. View your health check status in your Dashboard.

How to Submit a Household Check (For more than one student)

- 1. Open up your Fever Free app.
- 2. Select "Submit Health Check". You should see the names of each member of your household pop up. Select the individual you're submitting a health check for. Repeat steps below for each household member.
- 3. Tap the green check mark to confirm a temperature of less than 100.4 degrees.
- 4. Next, carefully follow along and select the appropriate responses to the questionnaire.
- 5. Tap submit when finished.

When your child arrives at school in the morning if they have a phone please have them show the clearance status to the staff member at the gate. If your child does not have a phone you can show your phone to the staff member to have your child receive a sticker to enter campus. If the student does not show the clearance we will have them line up so that we can check their name in the system. If the clearance has not been completed the student will not be permitted on campus. It is imperative that everyone does this prior to 8:00 am to streamline the entrance process daily. Thank you!
