



Earn Credits

- You need credits in order to graduate
- You earn 5 credits for each
 PASSED class
- You will take a minimum of
 6 classes each semester
- 6 classes x 5 credits = 30 credits for 1 semester

= 220 credits total There are 2 semesters in a year

Earn 60 credits in 1 year

A- G REQUIREMENTS For UC/CSU Admissions Grades MUST be "C-" or better

- a = History/Social Science 2 years
- b = English 4 years
- c = Mathematics- 3 years required, 4 years rec
- d = Laboratory Science 2 years required, 3 years rec.
- e = Language other than English 2 years required, 3 years rec.
- f = Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) -1 year required
- g = College Preparatory Electives 1 year required

It is similar to our graduation requirements - Need to take at least another year of math and science, along with 2 or 3 years of foreign language.




