First Grade Discipline Plan



Dear Parents,

In order to guarantee your child, along with the rest of the students in my class, the best possible learning environment, our first grade classroom will be using the "Stoplight" discipline plan.

Each student will have his/her own envelope on the behavior chart. In each envelope there will be a blue card, green card, yellow card, and red card.

Each child begins the day with a green card. The student's card will remain green as the child takes good care of him/herself, follows class rules and displays proper behavior and self-control. If a child chooses to not follow a classroom rule, he/she will have to flip their behavior card to yellow. If the improper behavior continues, the card is then changed to red.

Behavior cards are also used for good behavior. For example, if a student is on green, and he/she does something above and beyond of what is expected, then the student will get to flip their card to blue.

A behavior calendar (located in your child's homework folder) will be sent home at the end of each day, letting you know what color your child earned for the day. If your child earned yellow or red, he/she will complete a "Think About It" form. This form <u>MUST</u> be signed by the parent and returned the next day!

Students who earned a green (or blue) light for the whole week will be able to participate in Responsibility Club on Friday afternoon. Students who have two or more yellow lights or ANY red lights for the week, will <u>not</u> be able to participate in Responsibility Club. To keep you posted on your First Grader's behavior, take a look at the behavior chart and check for that green or blue mark!
