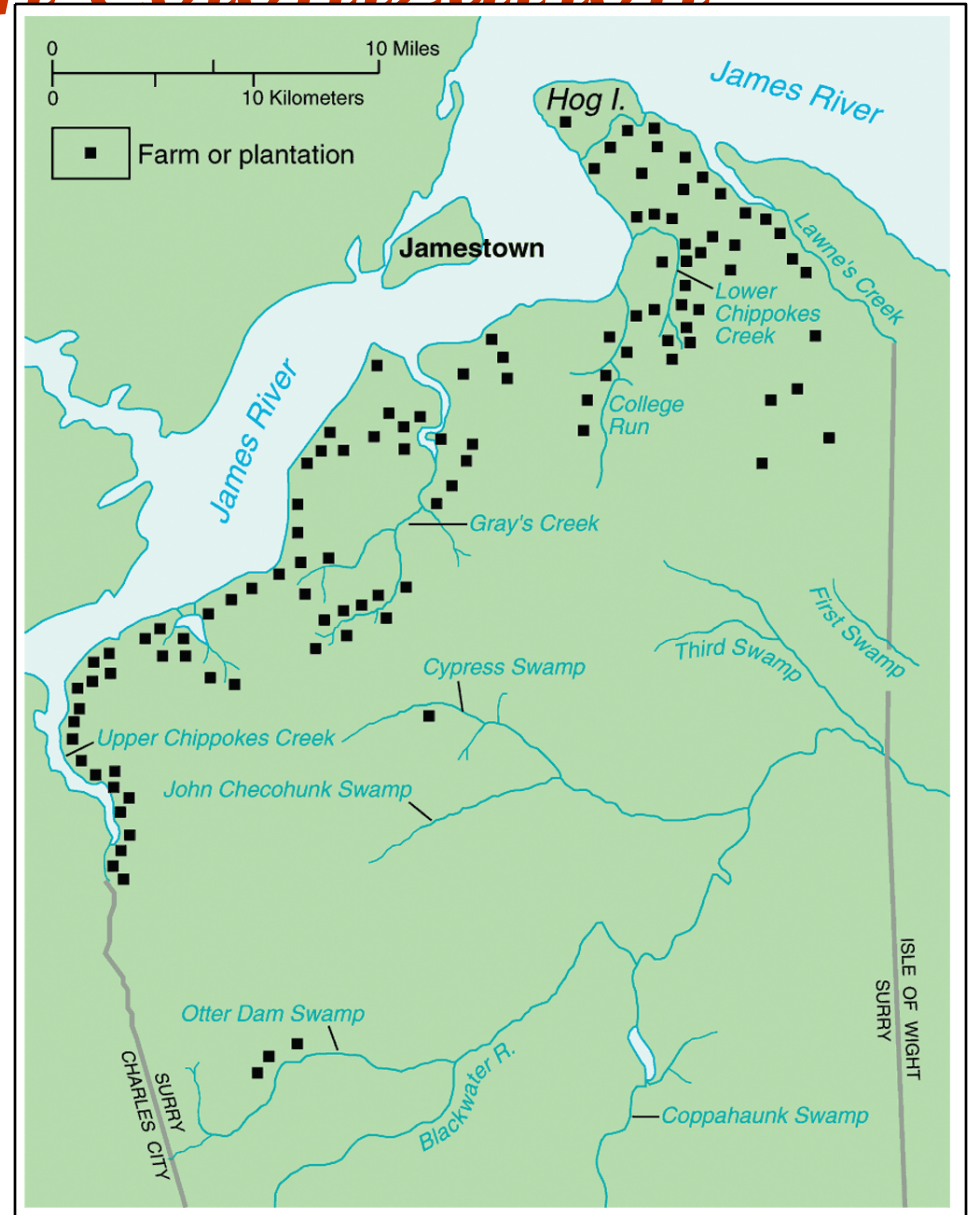

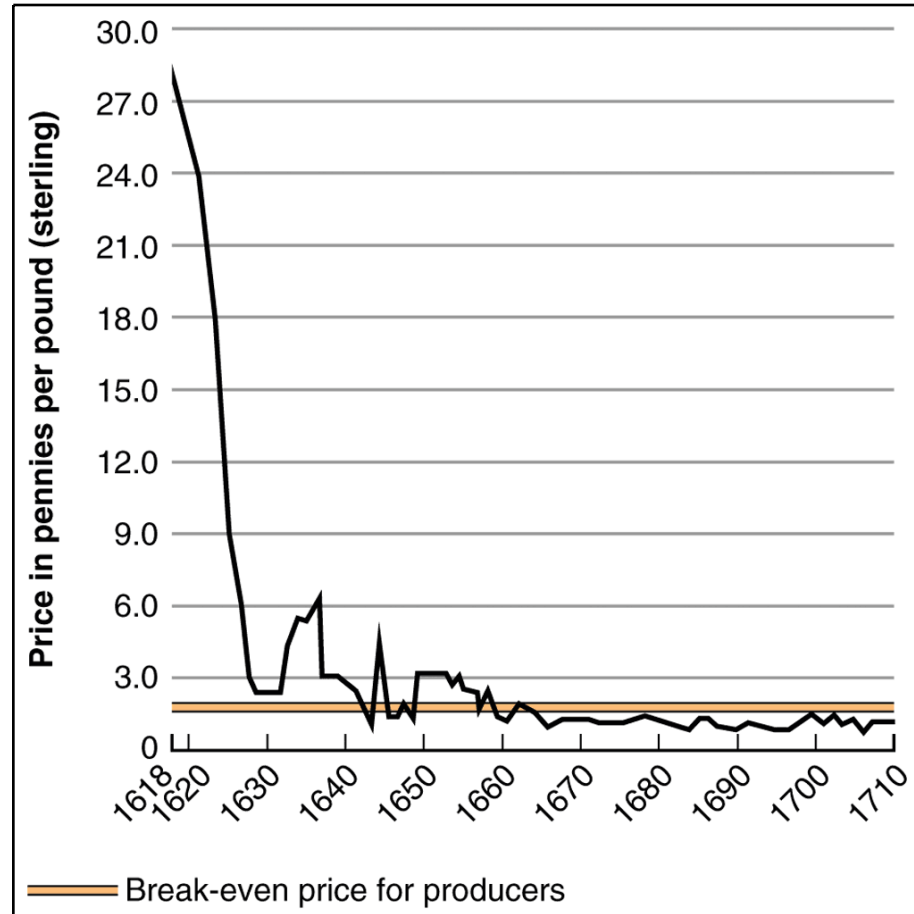

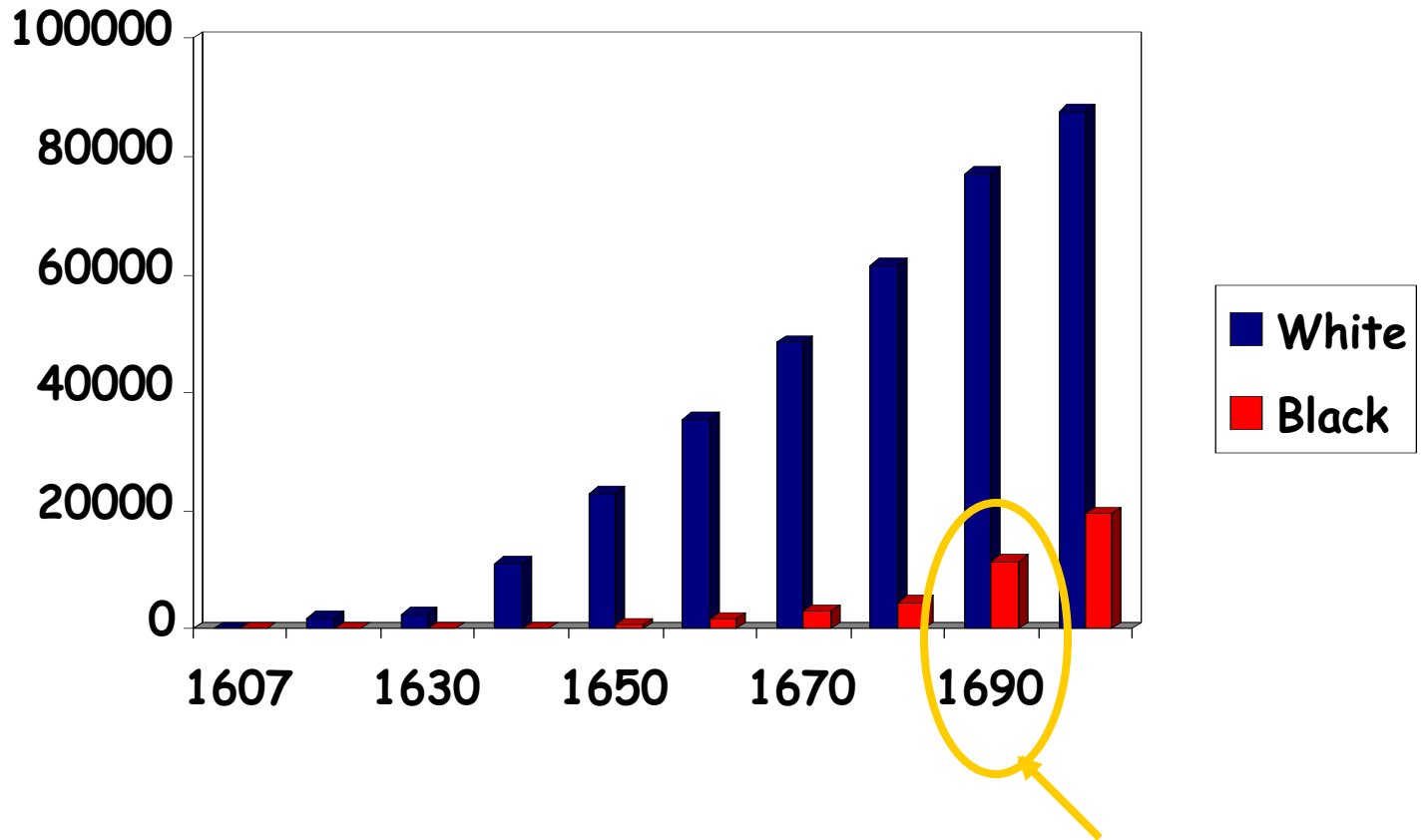


Tobacco Prices: 1618-1710



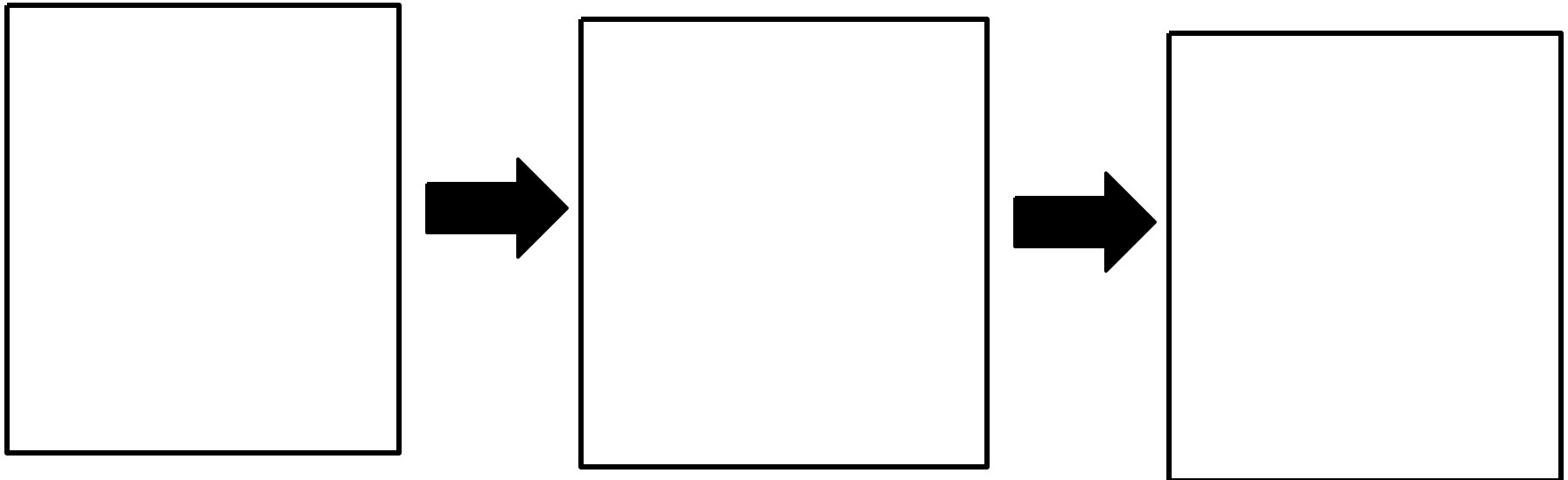
Why did tobacco prices decline so precipitously?

17^c Population in the Chesapeake



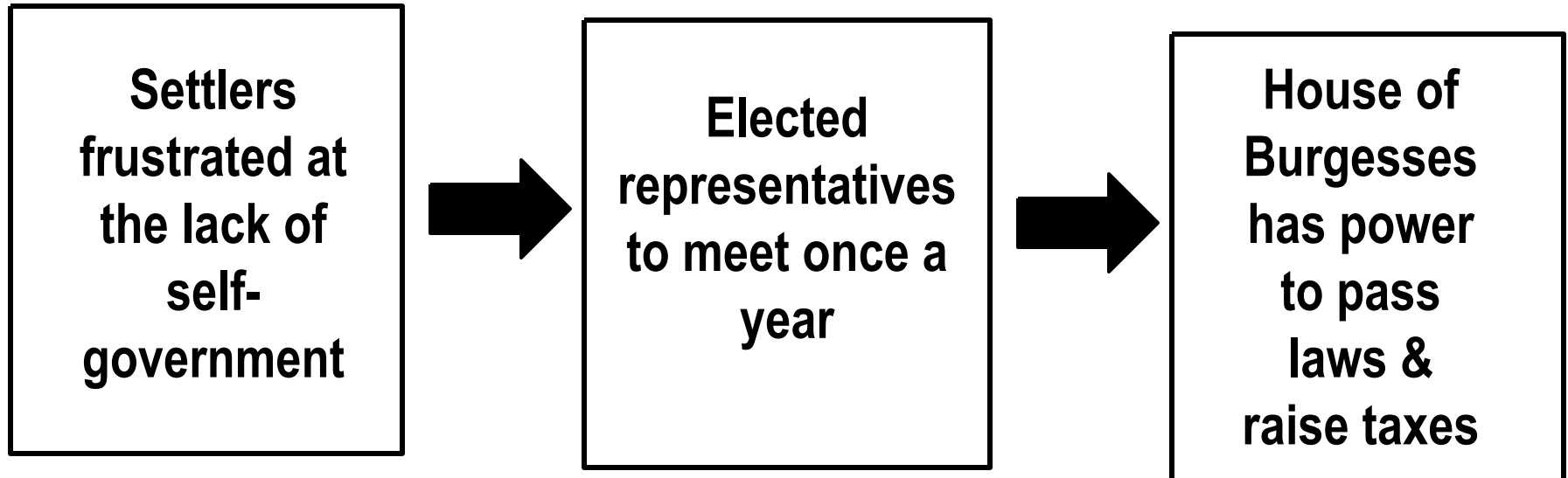
