Reading/Writing: In reading, students will focus on main idea. Students should be able to read a text and determine the main idea. In writing, we will continue working on opinion writing. Students will read articles and develop well written opinions based on the information in the text. I am meeting with reading groups each day. Please encourage your student to read each night at home.

Math: In February, students will continue working with fractions. Students will need to make equivalent fractions, compare fractions, add/subtract fractions, and multiply fractions by whole numbers. Please help your students as much as you can at home. Fractions can be challenging. I meet with math groups throughout the week. Those students will work on skills, strategies, and standards that they need to master. Please help your child work on addition, subtraction, and multiplication facts. If you need me to send home flashcards, please let me know.

Social Studies: We will continue learning about the people and history of Ohio.

Science: In the middle of February, we will switch to science. Students will begin the unit learning more about energy.
