Clean up after yourself, keep the classroom & materials in good shape.

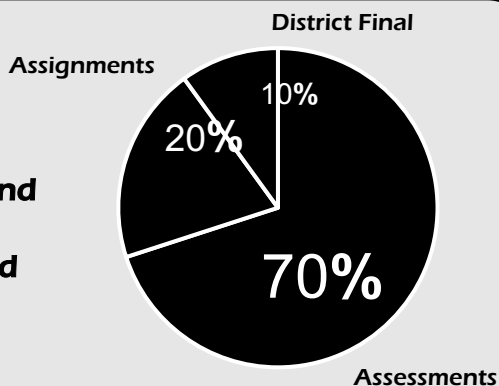
## Assessments

- We will also have a District Assessment at the end of each Trimester.

## Grading Scale &

Social Studies grades consist of three categories: Assignments, Assessments, and the District Final.

Assessments make up the largest portion of your grade and consist of unit quizzes and tests. Assignments are 20% of your grade and are made up of classwork, homework, and unit notes packets. The district final is given at the end of each trimester and consists of a multiple choice test and reading and writing exam.
