## Spelling Words

*The following is a list of spelling words. These words are content words related to The Road to Independence Reader.*

*The following chart provides the meanings of the spelling words. You are not expected to know the word meanings for the spelling assessment, but it may be helpful to have them as a reference as you practice spelling the words.*

<b>Spelling Word</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>surrender</b>	to give up, quit
<b>declaration</b>	an official statement of something
<b>valiant</b>	brave or courageous
<b>grievance</b>	a complaint resulting from being treated unfairly; a reason for complaining about a situation
<b>incident</b>	an event or disagreement that is likely to cause serious problems
<b>monarchy</b>	a form of government in which a country is ruled by a monarch, such as a king or a queen
<b>representative</b>	a member of a government
<b>independence</b>	freedom from outside control or support
<b>militia</b>	ordinary people trained to be soldiers but who are not part of the full-time military
<b>victory</b>	the act of defeating an opponent or enemy
