This year the students will study the different cultures and regions from Europe, Asia, Arabia, Africa and North and South America .

Materials Recommended:

1. Textbook: There is a class set of books in the classroom so every student has a book for class.
2. A folder to keep your papers.
3. Pencil or pen, Blue or black ink pens only.
4. College ruled paper
5. Blank white paper (copy paper)
6. Colored pencils, highlighters-5 colors
7. Glue stick
8. A ruler

Classroom Behavior

1. No food, gum or drink in class.
2. Cell Phones & iPods must be turned off. Those taken will be turned into the office.
3. Students must be in their seats when the tardy bell rings or they will be marked tardy.
4. Inappropriate behavior will result in a detention, referral to the office or suspension from class.

Daily Work

1. The majority of assignments will be started in class, if not completed then it becomes homework.
2. Two to three assignments are given per week and due within 1-2 days.
3. Vocabulary quizzes will be given each unit.
4. Assessments will be given every two to three weeks.
5. There are **NO EXTRA CREDIT** assignments given.

Late Work

I will accept most assignments as late work, but it will be marked down one grade for everyday that it is late. The day of the last Chapter Assessment will be the last day that I will accept any late work from that current chapter of study. At that time the highest grade possible for late assignments from that current chapter will be a 50%.

Essay/paragraph assignments **will not be accepted late** and will be scored as a **ZERO** once the assignment has been reviewed in class and/or returned to the students.

I do not accept any late work from any chapter once the last assessment has been completed for that particular chapter.

Grading

The overall semester grade is based on daily work (40%) and assessments (60%)
The grading scale will be the following for all work and test:

90%-100%	= A
80%-89%	= B
70%-79%	= C
60%-69%	= D
0%-59%	= F
