## LOCATION: Where is It?

#### Absolute Location:

is.

 Uses <u>latitude</u> and <u>longitude</u> (global location) or a street address (local location) to determine <u>exactly</u> where a place

#### Relative Location:

 Described by <u>direction</u>, <u>time</u>, <u>landmarks</u> or <u>distance</u> from one place to another.

What is it like there? What kind of place is it?

Human

**Characteristics** 

The main languages, customs, and beliefs. <u>Physical</u> Characteristics

> Landforms: rivers, lakes, mountains Climate, vegetation, wildlife, soil, etc.

# HUMAN-ENVIRONMENT INTERACTION



- How do humans affect their environment?
  - We depend on it:
    - People depend on the Tennessee River for water and transportation.
  - <u>We modify it</u>:
  - People change their environment by heating/cooling buildings for comfort.
    We adapt to it:
    - We adapt to the environment by wearing clothing suitable for the 4 seasons

### MOVEMENT

- How do people, goods and ideas move from place to place?
  - Human Movement: Trucks, Trains, Planes
  - Information Movement: Phones, computer emails, mail
  - <u>Idea Movement</u>: How do fads move from place to place? Through TV, Radio, Magazines









### REGION

- How are areas <u>similar</u> to and <u>different</u> from one another?
  - Formal Regions
    - Regions defined by <u>governmental</u> or <u>administrative boundaries</u>
    - Regions defined by <u>similar</u> characteristics such as the Corn Belt, Rocky Mountain region, Chinatown, etc.


