Geography and Early Japan Land of the Rising Sun

<u>Origin of the Name</u> Name comes from the Chinese symbols For "sun" & "source". Intended to call the country,"Nippon". Pronunciation came out "Jihpen".

<u>Main Idea: Geography shaped life in Japan.</u> Being an island nation led to isolationism and few foreign influences. Having few land resources led to a dependence on the sea and the resources found there.

<u>Creation of Japan</u> The Islands were created by the God, Izanagi. The Sun Goddess created the Japanese, Izanami. The Emperor is a God.

<u>Early Japan</u>

Early Japanese society was organized in clans which came to be ruled by emperors. The Ainu who were believed to come from Siberia & eventually disappeared. The Jomon people (Korea) migrated to the islands. Settled on the Yamato Plain and grew rice. Clans ruled until 400 A.D. Yamato Clan the first.

<u>Shinto</u> Based on nature. Divine spirits are known as the Kami. Everything in nature has *kami*. They built shrines to the *kami* and asked the spirits to bless them. Chiefs gained power through the Kami. The Sun Goddess the highest.

<u>Outside Influences</u> Sent to China to learn. Brought back many ideas. Chinese architecture. Chinese political system. Chinese writing system Buddhism (Korea)
