- Applicants must plan to attend an accredited post-secondary school full-time in the fall of 2023.
- Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be willing to submit a senior photo in digital format for Golden Belt Bank's use on their social media platforms.
- Applicants must agree to supply a copy of their college schedule before scholarship funds are released. Funds will be released to directly to their post-secondary school. (\$500 for fall semester and \$500 for spring semester)

- Include one letter of reference from a person outside of current academic setting.
- Include a high school transcript.
- Include resume (School, work, and volunteer activities during high school. Include any leadership roles you have held).
