GOLDWATER SCHOLARSHIP

The Goldwater Scholarship supports outstanding students interested in research careers in the natural sciences, mathematics, and engineering. The scholarship covers undergraduate eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board up to

\$7,500 PER ACADEMIC YEAR FOR UP TO 2 YEARS.

HOW TO GET NOMINATED

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for nomination, a student must:

- Have a minimum of one semester and no more than two years of undergraduate study remaining beginning September 2022.
- Pursuing a bachelor's degree on a full-time basis*.
- GPA of 3.0 or above.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Demonstrated interest in a research career in the natural sciences, mathematics, or engineering.

*As a result of COVID-19, some students may not be enrolled full-time during the 2021-2022 academic year. Schools may nominate these students as part of the 2022 Goldwater competition.

HOW TO APPLY

Complete a profile and 'pre-application' at goldwaterscholarship.gov.

Pre-applications will then be reviewed by MCC to nominate and submit one student for the Goldwater Schlolarship.

Official nomination announced in February.

DEADLINE

January 15, 2022: Pre-applications due to MCC

January 28, 2022: Official nomination submitted by MCC
