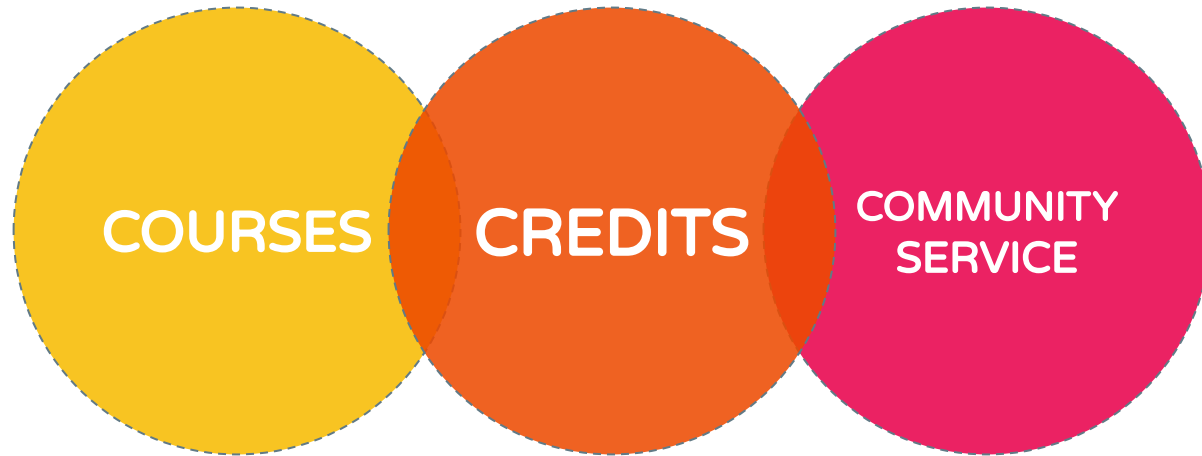

- ◎ Completed all required state assessments: SAT, M-STEP, WorkKeys typically taken in 11th grade year.

Requirements

What Is The SAT?

The SAT measures what students **KNOW** and how well they can **APPLY** that knowledge to a variety of situations.

Content & Format:

- 4.5 Hour Assessment
- 5 Test Components:
 - Reading
 - Writing & Language
 - Essay
 - Math Without Calculator
 - Math With Calculator
- No penalty for guessing
- Paper and pencil format


Useful Data:

- Most widely used college entrance exam.
- Almost all colleges and universities use the SAT as a component of admission decisions.
- A combination of a student's grades and SAT score is the best predictor of a student's success in college.
