## Navigation 101 Grade 12 12.11



### THEME: Planning for Life After High School

**Lesson Objectives:** Students will ensure they are on track for graduation.  
Students will review the High School and Beyond Checklist from 11<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Materials Needed:** 1. High School and Beyond Plan  
2. transcripts

Task Check List	Activities
<p>○ <b>Transcripts</b></p> <p>○ <b>High School and Beyond Plan</b></p>	<p>Seniors will be given the transcripts for first semester. Have them check for accuracy; for instance, does it show the requirement for Washington State History has been met? Does it show required test scores accurately? These need to be placed in the Academic Development section of the portfolio.</p> <p>Obligations need to be printed and placed in the portfolio by the end of May when portfolios are due. Students can print this from skyward. The pathway to this page will be given out in March during the final portfolio check before the due date of April 18th. Remind seniors again that there will be no NAV lessons in April, but they will be responsible for turning in portfolios to you by that date.</p> <p>Hand out to students a copy of the <b>High School and Beyond Plan</b>. This is the last time they will fill this out, but it is a portfolio requirement. Have students update the HS &amp; Beyond Plan with what they have completed this year.</p> <p>The complete H.S. &amp; Beyond Plan consists of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Personal essay: Students should have written a personal statement in their English classes. A revised and edited copy of that personal statement should be in the Personal and Social Development section of the portfolio. A college application essay could also be used instead of the personal statement.</li><li>2. Most recent transcript.</li><li>3. Planning Sheet in which students fill out courses taken each semester, each year.</li><li>4. Graduation Check List in which all earned credits can be checked off.</li><li>5. A completed financial plan which seniors did in NAV class in December.</li></ol>
