2020-2021 Test Administration

- GaDOE applied for a waiver of highstakes testing requirements in July 2020
 & again in February 2021 – waiver was denied by U.S. Department of Education
- Flexibility around testing stakes due to the pandemic
 - Extended state administration windows and additional flexibilities
 - State guidance: districts with flexibility contracts directed to waive promotion/retention consequences tied to Georgia Milestones
 - State guidance: Virtual students should not be required to come into building solely to test if they are uncomfortable doing so due to the pandemic



Reliability & Comparability

- From GaDOE: Scores should be interpreted in the context of the pandemic
- Tests were designed to measure a typical instructional environment – and 2020-2021 was anything but
- In general, year-to-year comparisons should not be made using school- and district-level data



Georgia Participation

Overall assessment participation rates for the state are lower when compared to previous years, likely due to health and safety concerns associated with in-person testing. The percent of enrolled students tested ranges from a high of 79% in grade 4 to a low of 55% in high school. While overall state rates are lower than normal, rates also vary across systems and schools.


Interpreting Results

Individual student results should be interpreted as one measure of a student's mastery of the knowledge and skills outlined in Georgia's academic content standards. These scores are most meaningful when considered in the context of learning and any associated extenuating factors. For example, a student's performance on Georgia Milestones may classify them as a Developing Learner, indicating the student mastered some, but not all, of the academic content standards. However, these scores cannot indicate whether the student had the opportunity to learn all of the content standards or whether, due to pandemicrelated learning disruptions, the student only had the opportunity to learn some of the content standards. In the context of the pandemic, many school districts had to prioritize which content standards could be delivered.

Interpreting Results

Summaries of results by student group, school, system, or state should likewise be interpreted as one measure of mastery of the knowledge and skills outlined in the state's academic content standards. These scores should not be used as a part of a longitudinal trend analysis without including context of this year's pandemic and associated learning disruptions, and varying access to instruction.
