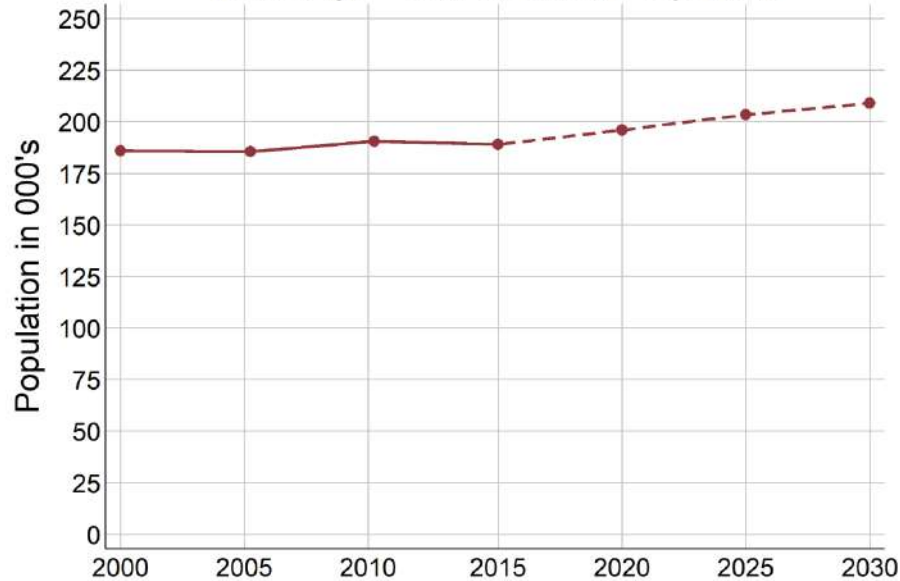

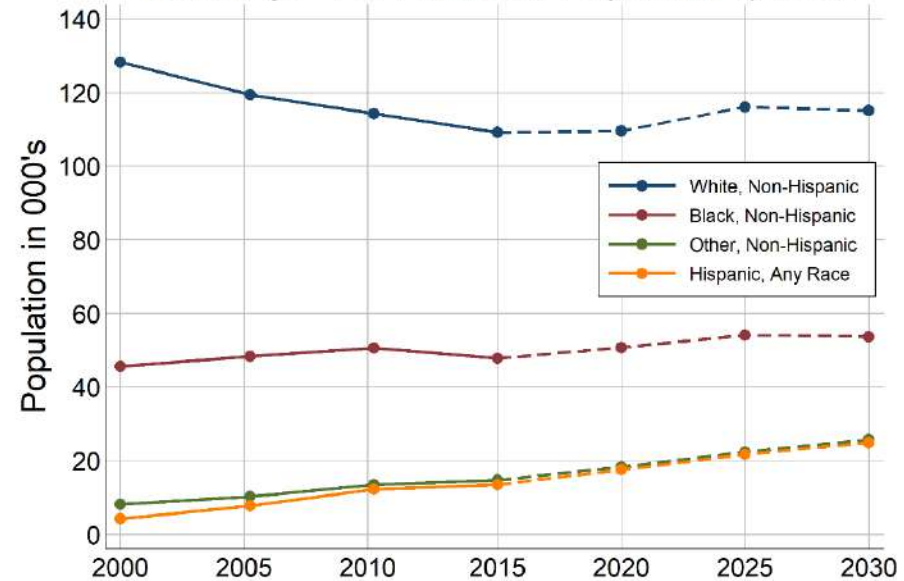
Population Projections

- Persons under the age of 20 number 195,115 in 2015 – forecast for 2030 is 208,276 (increase of 7%)
- The bulk of this growth will occur among minority children, particularly within the Hispanic and Asian groups

Youth (Age < 20) Population Projections

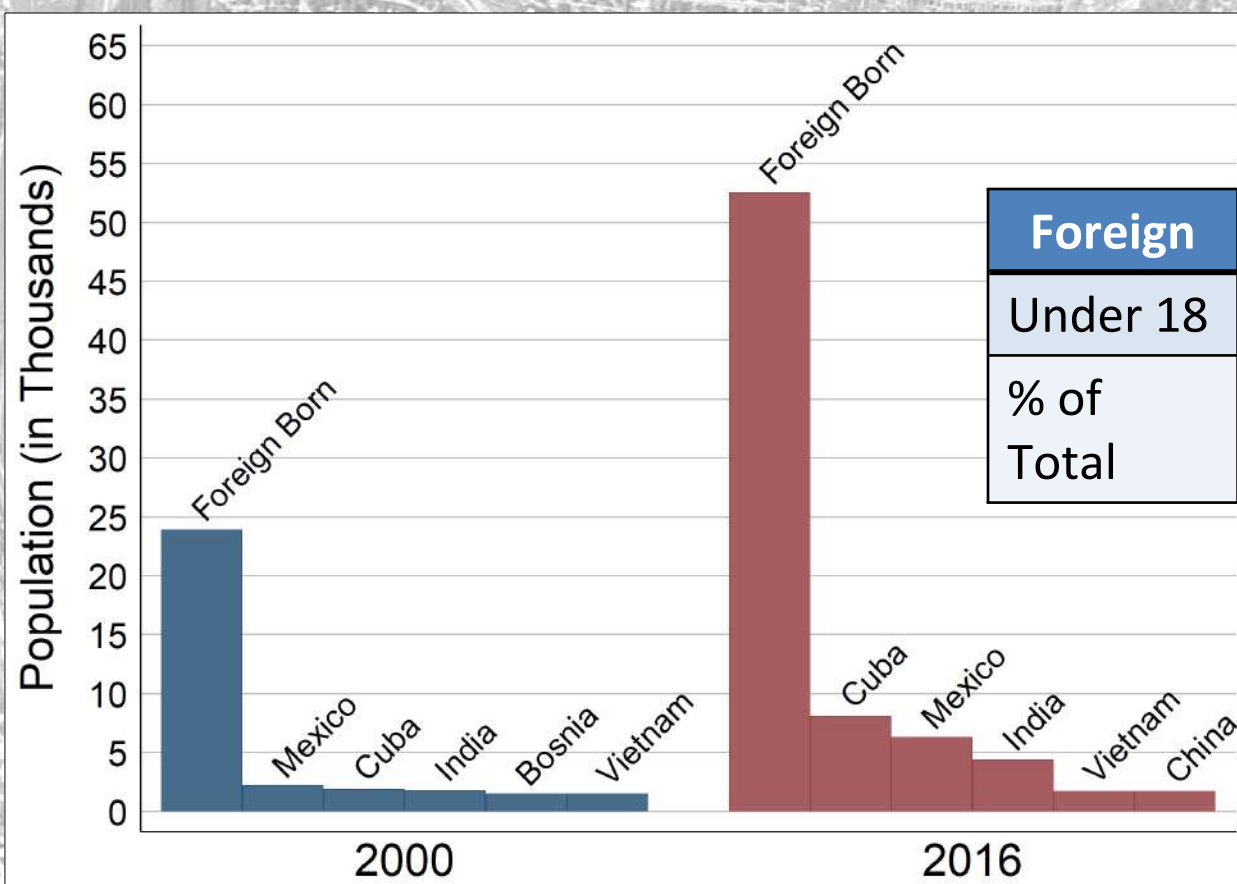


Youth (Age < 20) Population Projections by Race



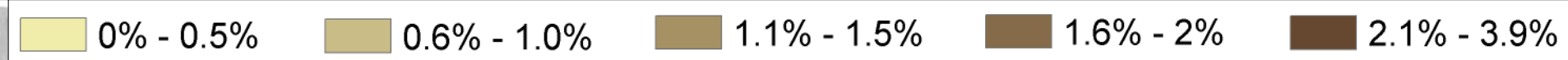
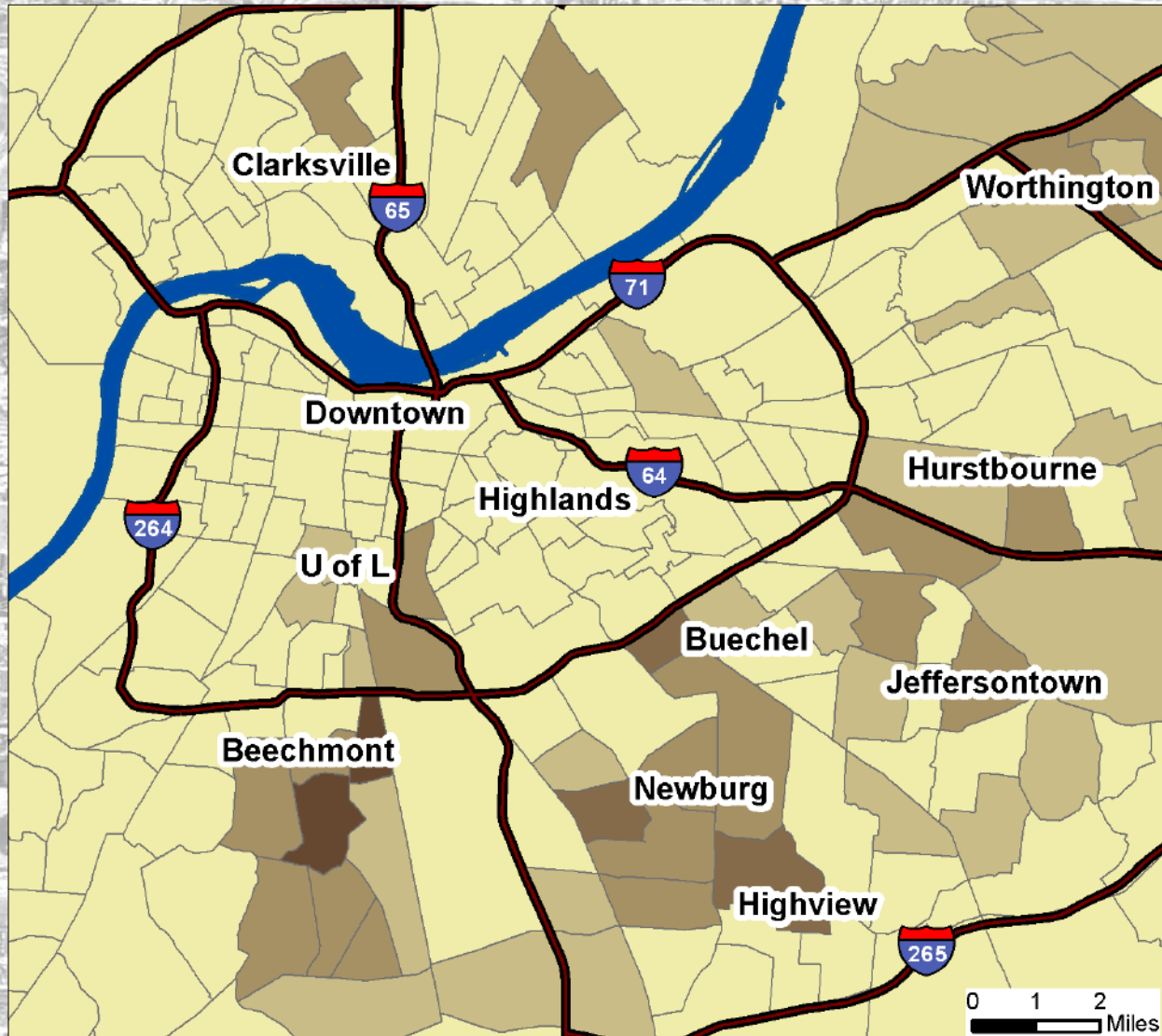
Foreign Born Population

- Between 2000 and 2016, the foreign born population grew by nearly 120% – greater growth among FB adults than FB children
- In 2016, in addition to the most common sending countries, there are large numbers of Iraqi, Filipino, and Somali immigrants



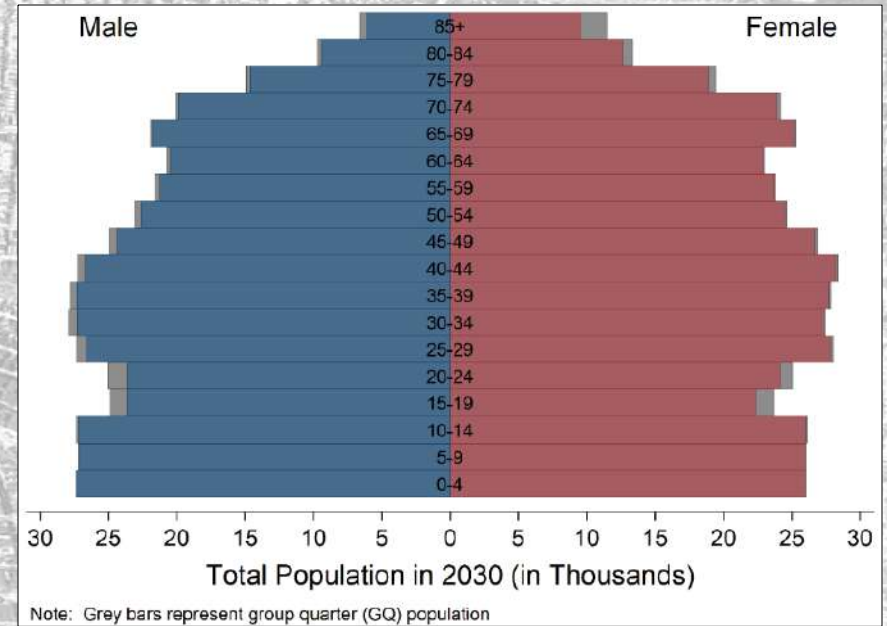
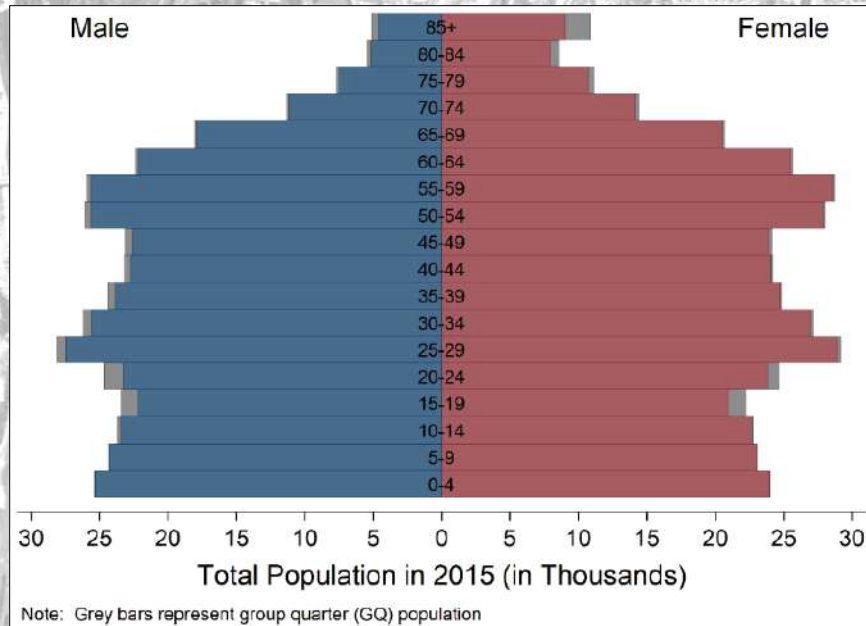

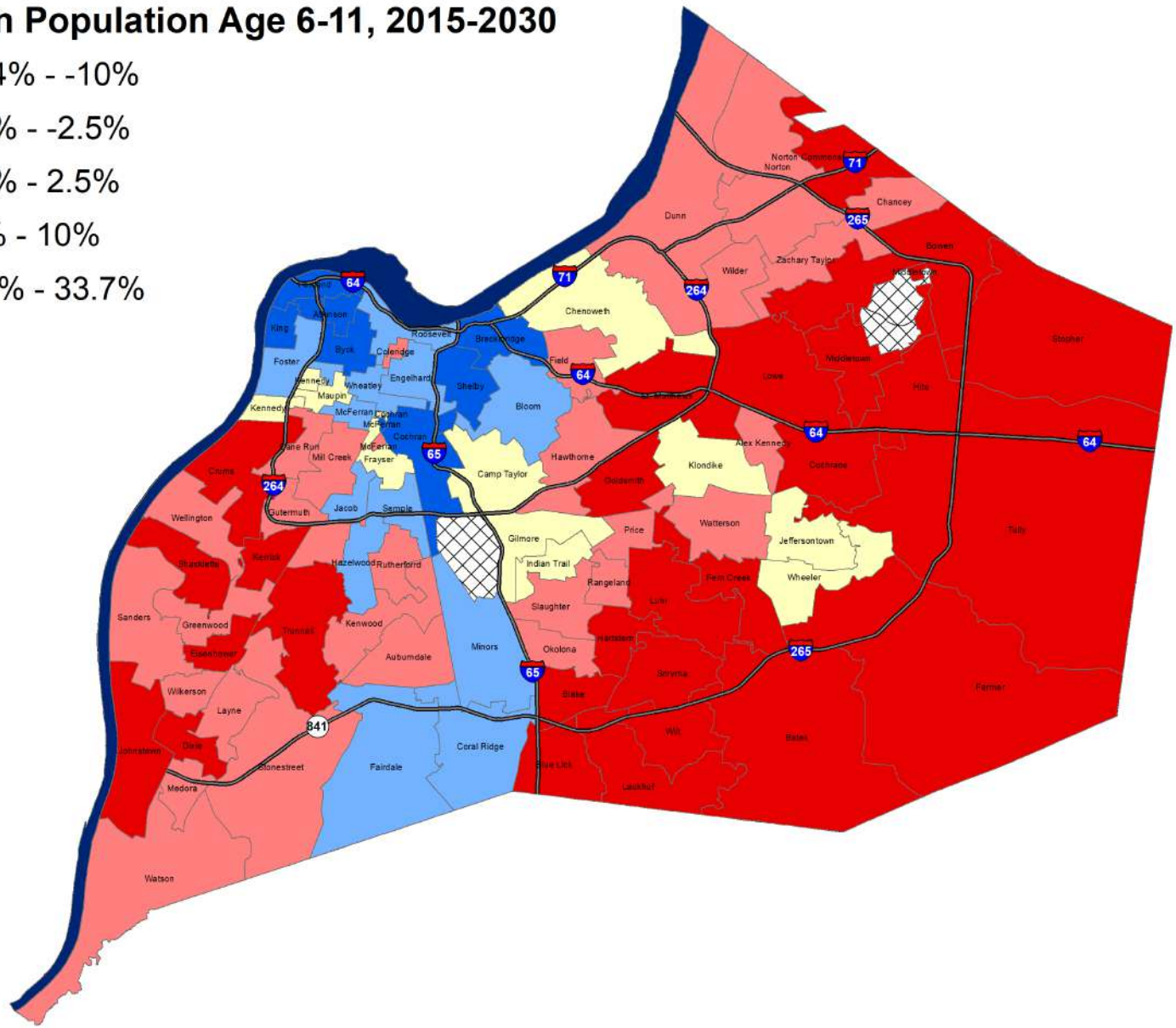

Change in Population Age 6-11, 2015-2030

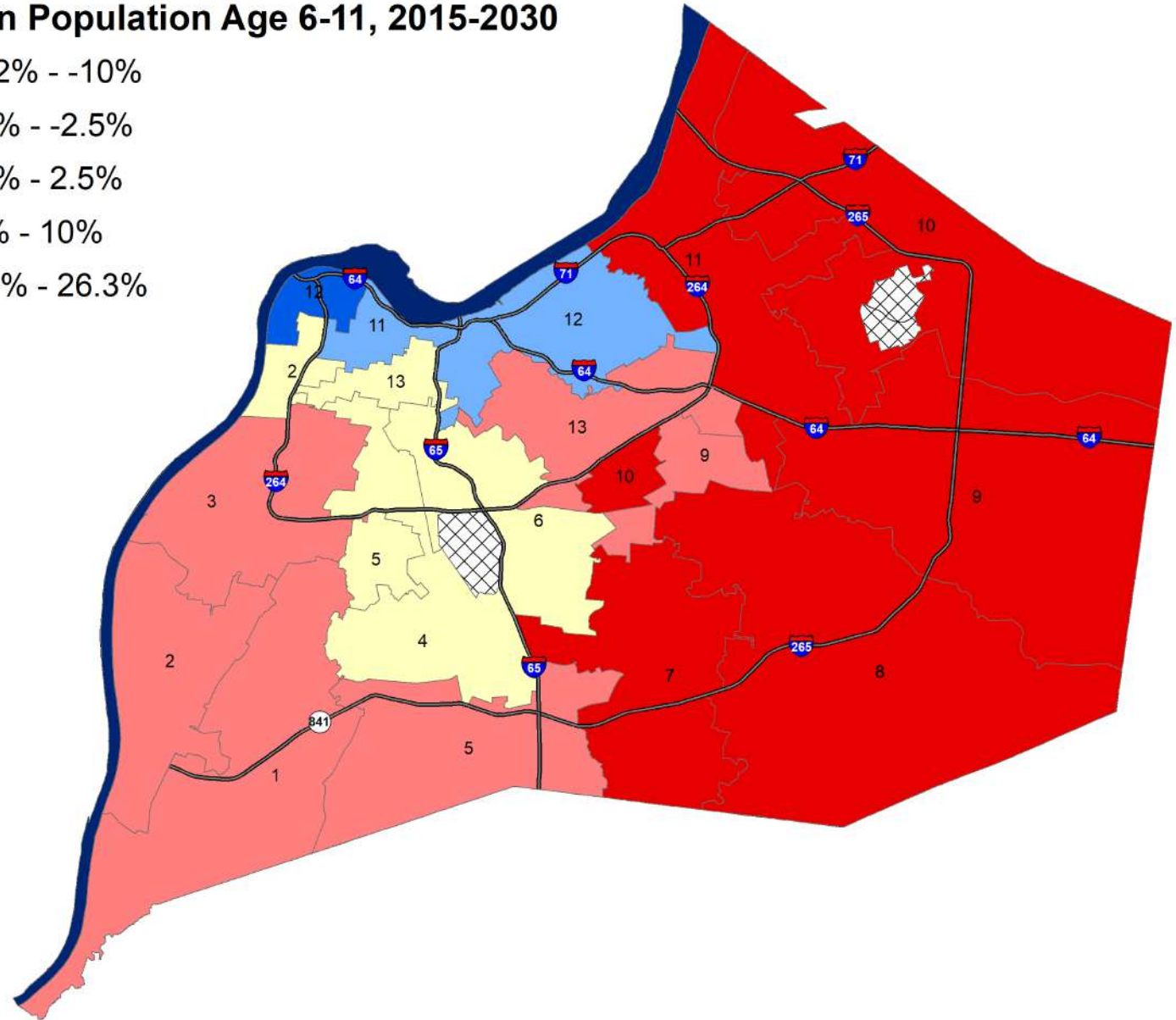
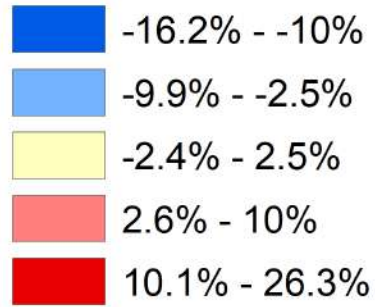

Elementary School Cluster Forecasts

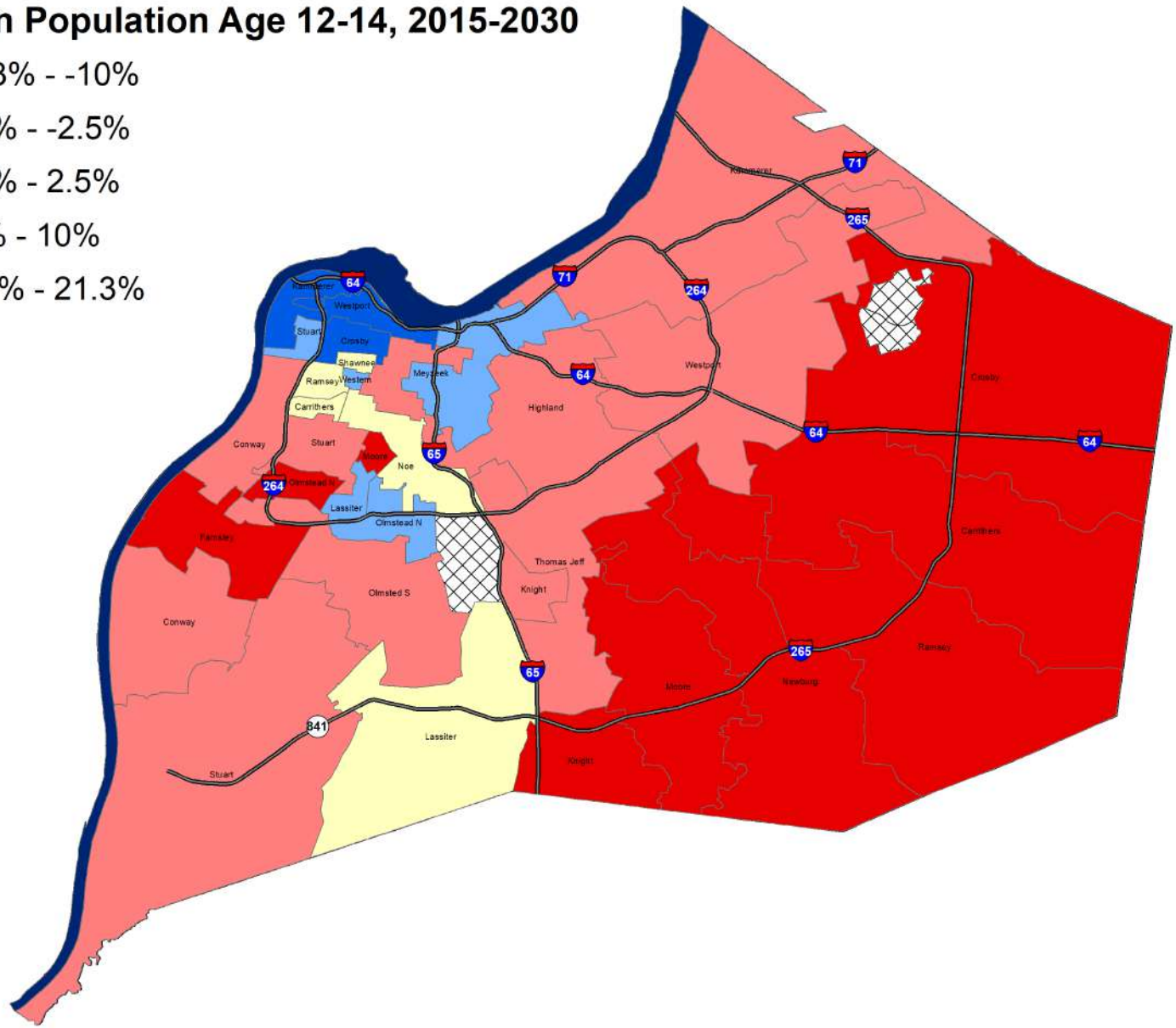
Change in Population Age 6-11, 2015-2030

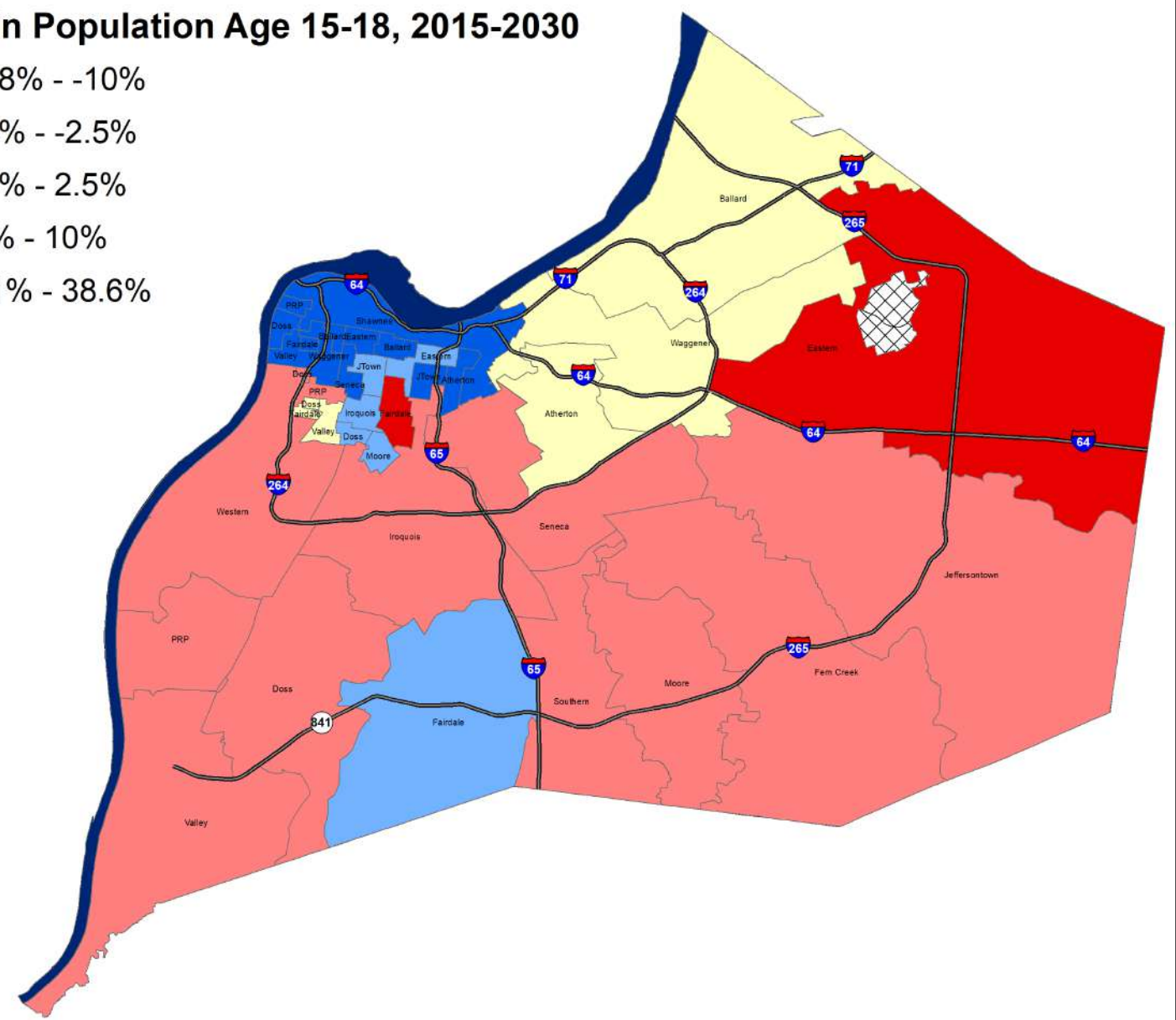

Change in Population Age 15-18, 2015-2030

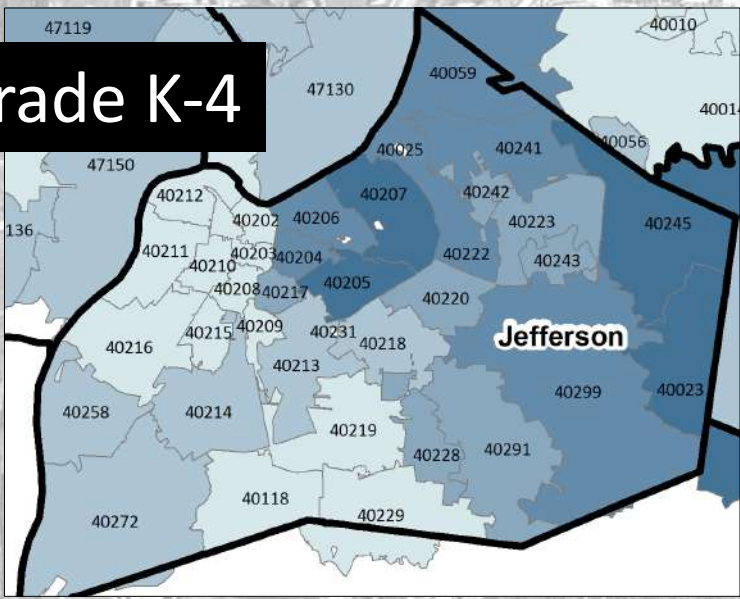

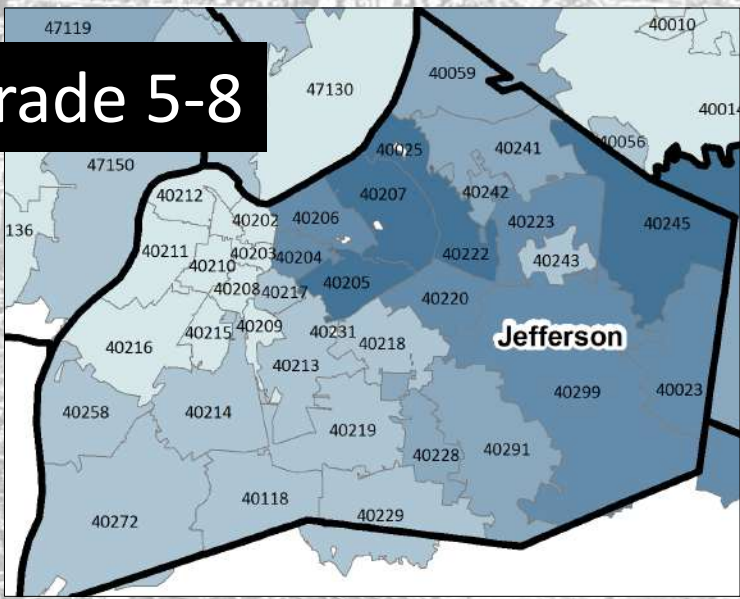

Private School Enrollment by ZIP Code

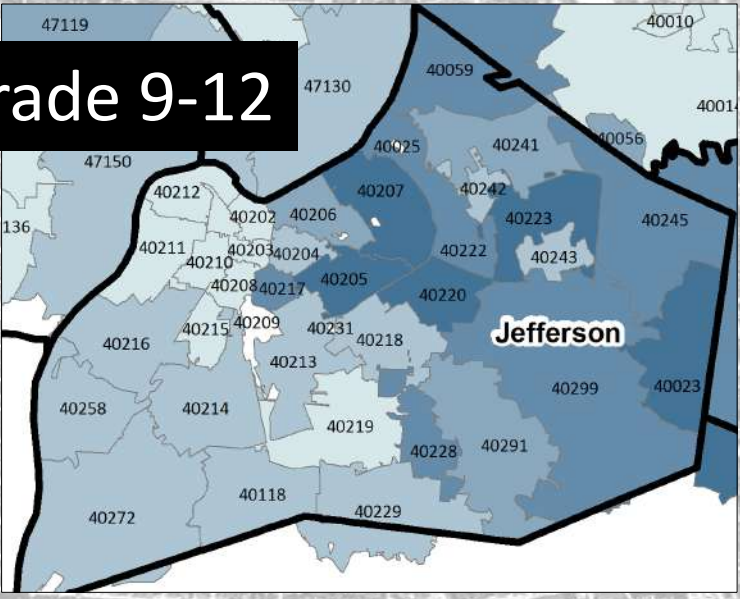
