






Population Projections




- Persons under the age of 20 number

- The bulk of this growth will occur among minority children, particularly within the Hispanic and Asian groups




Foreign Born Population








Elementary School Forecasts



Elementary School Cluster Forecasts




Middle School Forecasts






High School Forecasts
