Attendance Law & Policy

- Valid excuse notes must be submitted within 3 days of the student's return to school or the absence will remain unexcused.
- The following are valid reasons to be excused from school: illness, danger to health from serious exposure, quarantine, recovery from an accident, death of a family member, medical or dentist appointment when necessary, authorized school activities, preapproved educational travel (limit to 5 days), pre-approved college visits (limit to 2 days per year), pre-approved religious instruction (limit to 36 hours per year), and observance of the student's religion.
