RESTRICTION FROM EVENTS

- 2. Any student suspended on the day of an end of the year activity will not be allowed to participate in the day's activities. Any student who has accumulated twenty (20) demerits and is placed on restriction at the time of the end of the year activity will not be allowed to participate in the day's activities. Administration may prohibit students from participating in the end of the year activities based on behavior, discipline, or safety concerns. The student will lose any and all money paid for the activity.
- 3. Any student with an outstanding Accountability Restrictions, for lost books, locks, etc., will not be allowed to participate in the end of year activities unless Accountability Restrictions are taken care of on or prior to Friday, June 1, 2019. The student will lose any and all money paid for the activity.
