### GRADE PK-5

- Remote Learning Students will be assigned to a cohort of students in the same grade level who are also learning remotely.
- A certified teacher will be assigned to each remote learning cohort.
- As required by regulation, remote learners will still receive PE instruction remotely.
- Details around remote Art and Music instruction are still being addressed.
- Students will receive “face-to-face” instruction two days a week with independent work and assignments along with individual check-ins from the teacher as needed.

### GRADE 6-8

- Remote Learners will have a schedule of classes that they will follow and join “in-person” classes in real time.
- Instruction will be done to the extent possible synchronously using mirroring programs. At times, given the type of instruction during the “in-person” class, remote learners may be asynchronous.
- One section of each class will be recorded and posted in the course’s Google Classroom to ensure equity and access for all students.

### GRADE 9-12

- Instruction may be synchronous or asynchronous depending on the content area, course, or unit of study.
- Remote Learners will have a schedule of classes that they will follow and join “in-person” classes in real time when possible.
- Synchronous instruction will use mirroring programs where appropriate.
- Recorded instruction will accompany assignments.
