

CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

- **Be Safe-** use safe websites on Class Link
- Be Responsible- be ready to learn at 8:40am, complete all work
- Be Respectful- stay muted, say "excuse me" to speak
- Be Kind- listen to others, use kind words & actions
- As a class: I recognize positive/negative behaviors. If the class attains more positive recognition during a day, they earn a short celebration time as a reward at the end of the day.
- Individually: I use a "3 strikes" system. If your child ever has continued difficulty with any of the rules, you will receive a message from me.




GOOGLE CLASSROOM

- Look at the icons for Material vs. Assignment. When you have an Assignment to turn in, please click to turn it in twice. Assignments are graded on a rubric of 1, 2, 3, or 4.
- The Material icon tells the work we will do by subject with the page numbers in the book. Parents can assist their child by using a bookmark in each page of a book to be used for that day. Have paper, pencils, and crayons ready each day.
- Find the Goggle Meet link in Google Classroom. Be on time for our daily 8:40 meeting. Be sure to stay muted. If you need to speak, be sure to raise your hand or say, "excuse me".



HOMEWORK

- During Distance Learning, homework is integrated into classwork. During Blended Learning, we do homework regularly to support the math and language arts lessons we are learning in class.
- Please be sure to add 20 minutes of reading, including sight word practice, as part of the daily homework schedule.
- If a student is missing classwork or homework, the parent will be contacted. This will impact your child's participation grade.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Don't help your child with tests. I need to know how much your child already knows & what I still need to teach them. If your child is an early finisher, have a book to read, ten frames & counters, or a white board & marker available.
- We will have online Parent Conferences on Google Meet using the link in Google Classroom. The conferences will be held Monday-Friday, September 21-25. I will send you a message on Remind to sign up for a time using Sign Up Genius.
- You may order books from Scholastic using my class code: J3B6X. I will let you know when the books arrive at school. If you wish to order books from Scholastic for home delivery, go to the Scholastic Pop-Up Shop: https://shop.scholastic.com/parent-ecommerce/clubs.html
- Starfall and Freckle are two programs that will soon be available to provide extra reinforcement of first grade Common Core Standards at home. I will let you know as soon as they are ready for your use.





Distance Learning Expectations

- Dress code
 - Scholars must wear school-appropriate clothing
 - Shirts required

 - Send chat message to Professor to let them know why student stepped away

Distance Learning Attendance

- Attendance is mandatory
- Excused absences
 - Doctor/dentist appointments
 - Illness
 - Sporadic lack of internet or adult supervision to log student on
- Contact Professor ASAP!
 - Some absences from virtual classroom can be cleared by completing assignments

Distance Learning Attendance

- According to state law, students receive marks for attendance AND participation
- Participation expectations
 - Scholars log in to the virtual classroom during scheduled class time
 - Scholars interact with teacher and/or other students about curriculum during scheduled class time
 - Scholars complete assignments during scheduled class time
