Weekly Schedule

★ Students come on campus for in-person instruction on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.

★ Students are at home for virtual instruction on Wednesdays for Community Connect.

★ School is in session from 8:30 a.m. until 12:40 p.m.

 Distance learning students will be taught simultaneously with in-person students.

All students must enter campus independently and walk to class without a parental escort. Older Foster students can escort younger siblings to class by entering at the younger sibling's gate. Staff will be available to guide students to class.

There is no supervision before 8:25 a.m.

Materials

- ★ Students will bring their Chromebooks to and from school each day. Please make sure that it is fully charged the night before.
- ★ Students will bring textbooks to and from school each day as directed by their teacher.
- \star Needed materials will be provided by the school.
- * Students can keep learning materials in individual desks.
- ★ Desks and learning materials will not be shared by any other student.
- * Packets of individual wipes are supplied to each student.
- * Plexiglass dividers are provided for each student.

Daily Schedule

- 10:25-10:45 Fresh Air Time: K1 & K9
- 10:50-11:10 Fresh Air Time: 26, 32, 35, 36 & 53
- 12:40 Dismissal & Grab-and-Go Lunch Available

Arrival

- * Students will be allowed to enter campus no earlier than five minutes prior to their start time.
- ★ Students will stand on markers positioned 6' apart along sidewalks nearest to the assigned grade level entry door.
- ★ Once on campus, students will move into their classroom.
- ★ No adults outside of Stephen Foster staff will be permitted on campus.
- ★ Students MUST wear a mask prior to entering school and wear it for the entirety of the school day.
- ★ If students are late to their gate, they must enter through the main office and get a tardy slip.

Fresh Air Breaks (Recess)

- ★ Each class will have an assigned area on the grass for Fresh Air Time.
- ★ Students will use their assigned restroom during Fresh Air Time.
- ★ Students are encouraged to bring a snack to enjoy.
- ★ Students are encouraged to bring a refillable water bottle. There are two refillable water bottle stations available.
- ★ Students are encouraged to bring a small, individual item for play. Students cannot share their items with other students and will not be able to play with their items during instructional time. No electronics allowed.

Grab-and-Go Lunch

★ Grab-and-Go lunch is available as students are dismissed.

\star Students will need to eat off campus.

★ Only Expanded Learning Program students will eat lunch at Foster.

Dismissal

- ★ Dismissal is at 12:40 p.m.
- \star Students will be monitored to maintain a safe 6' distance from each other.
- \star Students are to be picked up at their assigned entry and exit gates.
- \star Students must be picked up on time.
- \star Students will be required to wear a mask while exiting campus.
- \star No adults outside of Stephen Foster staff will be permitted on campus.
- ★ Students will not be permitted to return onto campus once dismissed from class.
- ★ Previously enrolled Expanded Learning Program students will have supervision until 3:00 p.m.

Safety Recap

- ★ Families must conduct Daily Screening 30 minutes prior to each student arriving to school every day. Students arriving to school without having completed the screening, will need to meet with the Health Assistant to complete the screening prior to entering campus.
- ★ Students must wear masks the entire time they are on campus. Younger students are encouraged to bring an extra mask.
- ★ Students must maintain social distancing of at least six feet while walking around campus, during Fresh Air Time, and in common areas.
- \star Students are required to wash their hands frequently and/or use hand sanitizer.
- * Students that are required to isolate must be picked up within thirty minutes.

Students who do not follow safety protocols will have parents contacted immediately.

After three conferences, students will return to distance learning.

Safety Continued

★ If your child or a close contact of your child (member of your household or someone your child has been exposed to with less than 6' of distance for 15 minutes or more) has tested positive for COVID-19, please do not bring your child to school. However, please notify our office: (562) 804-6518.

★ If your child is exhibiting symptoms associated with COVID-19, please do not bring your child to school. Please notify our office: (562) 804-6518 and seek guidance from your medical professional.
