

G.P.A. = Grade Point Average

Grade Points:

A = 4 points

B = 3 points

C = 2 points

D = 1 point

F = 0

Definiton: A grade point average (G.P.A.) is a number that represents the average value of all of your grades.

Question: How do you calculate your G.P.A.?

Answer: You add your grade points and divide that total by the number of classes (six) you have. See the example below...

Important: To be eligible to participate in school activities you need a G.P.A. of 2.00 or higher.

To be on the honor roll you need a G.P.A. of 3.00 or higher.

Example:

Sara's grades...

Math	B+	= 3 points
History	A-	= 4 points
PE	B	= 3 points
Language Arts	C+	= 2 points
Computer Lit.	A	= 4 points
Science	B-	= 3 points

Total: = 19 points
