# Grade 1 – Assignment for week of (5/26 to 5/29)

## Learning about Earth's Seasons:

The last few weeks we have studied the different parts of the weather and how to measure the weather.

This week we will start to learn about Earth's different parts of the year called the seasons.

# **Science Vocabulary:**

**Task #1:** Read and review the words and share with a parent or guardian or think to yourself.

Season: one of the four 3-month periods of the year

Spring: season between winter and summer when plants begin to grow

Summer: season between spring and fall that is the hottest time of year

Fall: season between summer and winter when some trees drop their leaves

Winter: season between fall and spring that is the coldest time of year

#### Task #2:

Use words from the science vocabulary listed above, to make an **acrostic** telling about Earth's seasons. An acrostic uses each letter in the word to describe the word or tell a story about what you are learning. Make an acrostic for (3) vocabulary words.

An example for the word *Earth Day* might be:
