Grade Suppression Request

Repeated course for Credit Grade Suppression is a process that replaces a previously stored failing or non-failing grade with a new stored grade on a student's transcript. This process, commonly referred to as grade suppression, may improve a student's academic standing in a course and allow him/her to demonstrate further mastery of the course's curricular content. This policy applies to courses taken in 2015-16 and thereafter.

Suppression of a grade means the suppressed grade is:

Excluded from the GPA Excluded from the transcript Excluded from Class Rank Excluded from Honor Roll

Students who are repeating a course for credit and wish to have the previously earned mark replaced, must make an official declaration of their intent within the first 10 days of the course. Only one course per academic year may be taken for suppression. *Warning, the new earned final grade will be the grade of record even if the previous score was higher.
